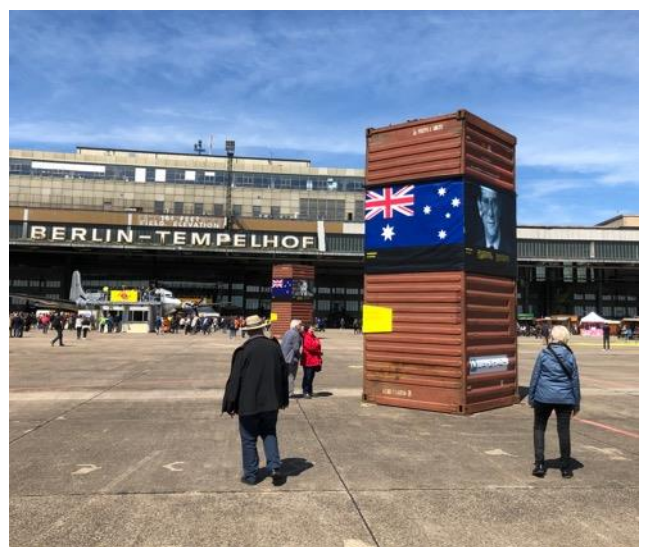

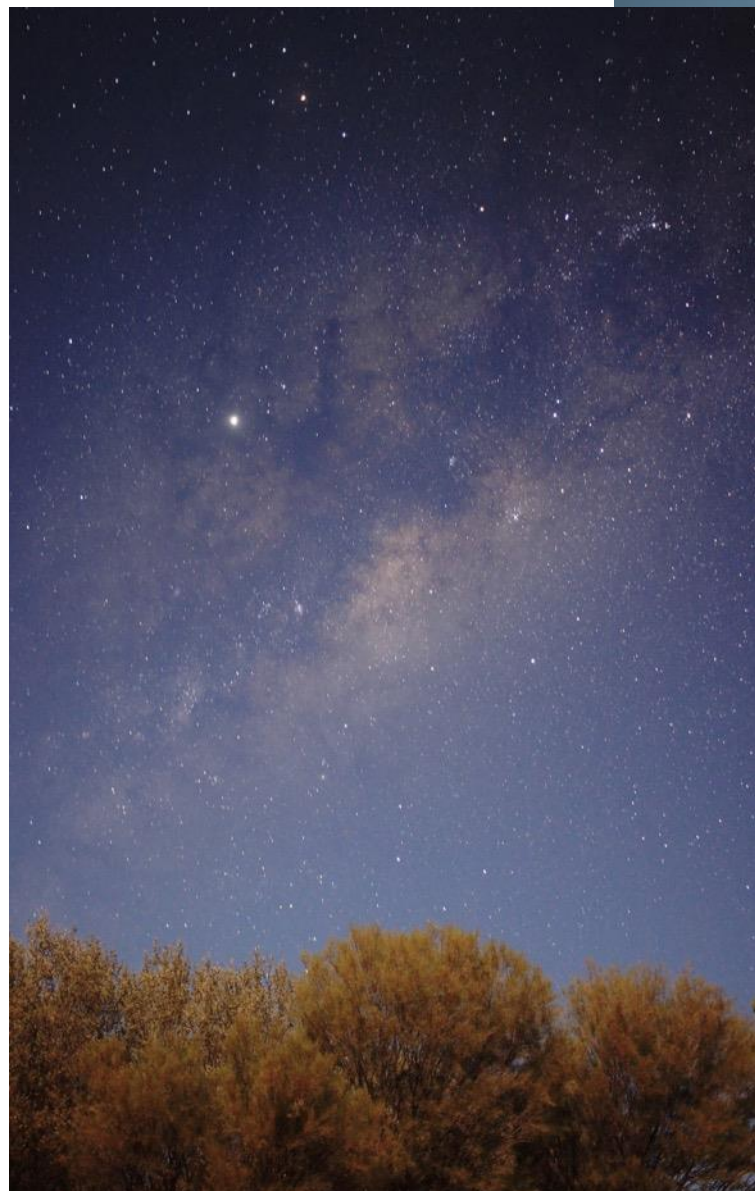
ROTARY SHOW PACK UP

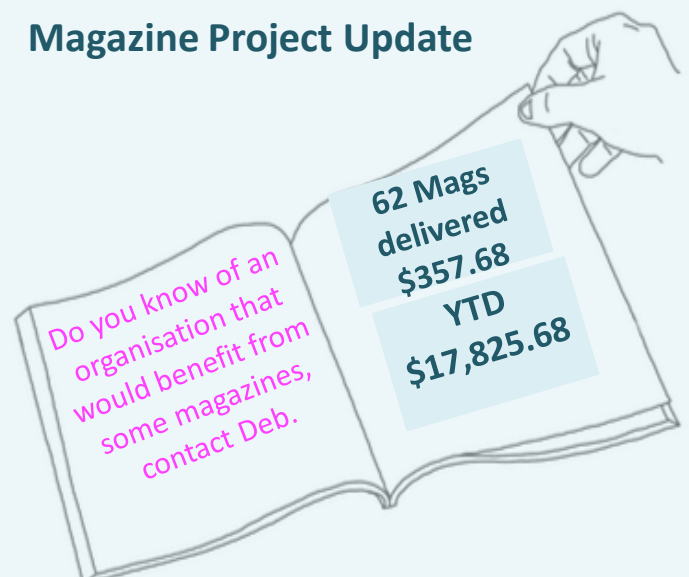
