attracted nearly 100 participants. The walkers – many clad in red, blue, yellow, and purple End Polio Now T-shirts strolled, socialized, beat drums, and tooted horns along a roughly 2-mile route.

LAST MEETING'S HIGHLIGHTS

Our speaker this last week was Stephen Beckett, Head of Public Affairs at Brisbane Airport accompanied by Rishi Wijesoma, Government Policy Lead.

Our entire group was interested in the developments happening at the Airport over the next few years and there were plenty of questions from the group.

Some of the big ticket items include the Aeromedical Base a \$72 million project that will accommodate the RFDS, Lifeflight and Queensland Health facilities and connect more Queenslanders to major hospitals and life-saving care.

A Terminal Screening Upgrade which will see a third level added to the terminals to accommodate new equipment - this will put Brisbane on track with global security screening standards.

In addition to this are carpark upgrades, mall precinct expansion and work on getting the Domestic and International terminals ready for the increased requirements of the Olympics and Paralympics in 2032.

- take them to the University, assist in opening a bank account (A scholarship payment would have been forwarded to them), assist with setting up their mobiles and assist them to obtain their student ID card.
- invite them to your Rotary Club Meetings particularly for special occasions. Lectures for Peace Fellows usually commence around 5.30pm and go to 8.00 pm or 9.00 pm.
