On 19 March 2023, the club in partnership with the Alliance of Guest Workers Outreach (AGWO), launched a 6-month cricket programme for migrant workers at Tuas South Recreation Centre. AGWO is a movement of Hope Initiative Alliance (HIA), to provide holistic care for vulnerable communities. AGWO runs activities at Tuas South Recreation Centre, set up for 100,000 isolated guest workers' emotional and physical wellbeing.

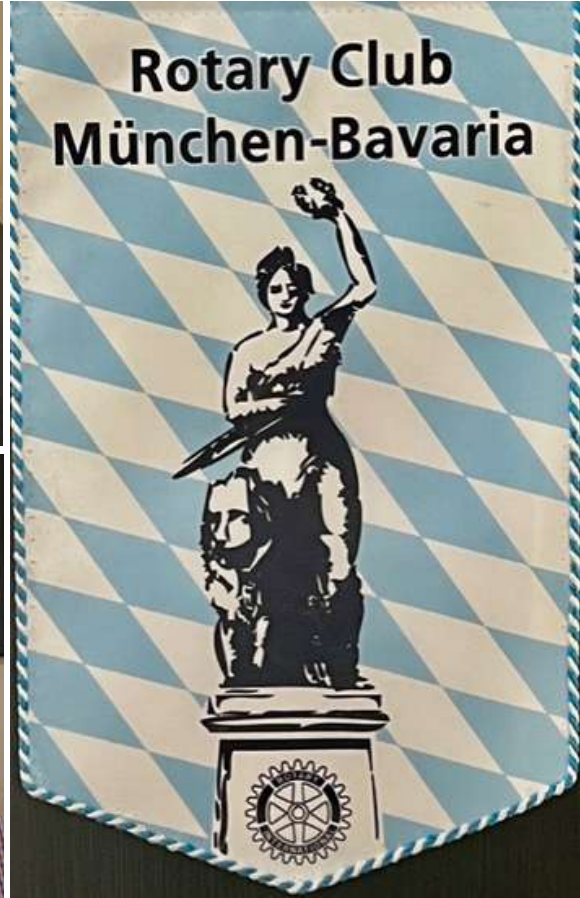

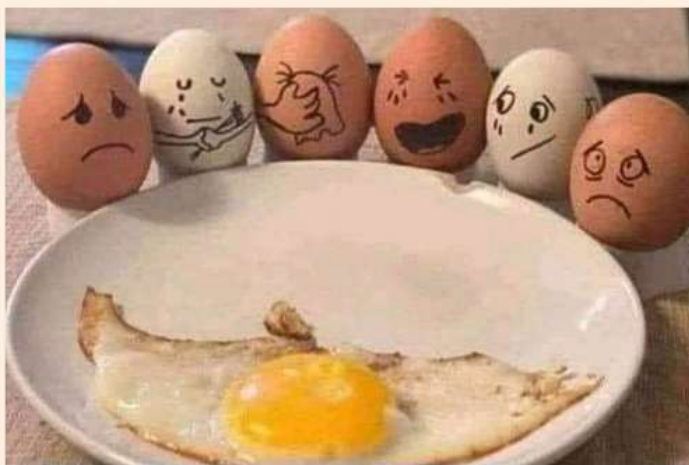
