A 2024 Qld Senior Australian of The Year nominee, A 2024 Qid Senior Australian of the Year hominee, longtime Ipswich Rotarian, businessman and philanthropist, Martin Corkery, co-founded Children First Learning Centres more than 30 years ago. Guided by the Rotary motto of 'Service above self', he has also dedicated prodigious time – and his own funds – to community causes in Australia and internationally.

Now retired, this intrepid octogenarian self-funded two visits in 2023 to post-invasion Ukraine to establish links with local Rotary clubs and establish how Rotary Australia could best offer support to Ukrainian people. Martin flew into Poland, organised a guide to take him over the border and paid to stay with a local family in Ukraine. Thankfully, he videorecorded his experiences.

And it was this riveting and confronting video, presented by his colleague Jan Briggs that was shown at last week's breakfast meeting. And yes, you could have heard a pin drop.

Indomitable Rotarian that he is, Martin plans to return to the Ukraine in 2024 to see what more might be done to aid the suffering population. Meanwhile, he says, financial donations to Rotary International are sorely needed to keep families going, with even the most basic needs. If you'd like

Fly From Everest is a feature documentary filmed and directed by QUT's own Senior Lecturer in Film and Screen Dr Joe Carter, which was filmed over 8 months in Australia and Nepal in 2022.

Fly From Everest follows retired police officer Ken Hutt (a Rotarian from Berry in NSW) who sets out to become the first person to fly a paraglider from the summit of Mt Everest to raise funds and awareness of Rotary International's primary project – to finally eradicate Polio from the world. It is a gripping story of adventure, challenge, and survival in one of the highest places on Earth, with a powerful message about the importance of Rotary's End Polio Now project.

Fly From Everest is currently touring international film festivals with excerpts screening at international documentary and medical conferences, and QUT is very proud to host this special VIP screening event in November as the Queensland Red Carpet Premiere. The evening also will feature a Q&A session with the stars of the film, the director, and a special guest who inspired the whole team to keep motivated – Polio survivor, Rotarian and Polio Australia Board Member, Gary Newton.




