Since my last update I have been to Sweden with my host family for 5 days where we had a nice relaxing holiday in Lund looking at museums and art galleries while scoping out the Swedish dining scene. After my return to school the following week I attended my first Gymnasium Party which was held at the school. My school life is pretty tough as I still can't understand what is being said but I try to pick out words that I know. Despite this I think my Danish is coming along slowly and I can definitely feel myself being able to read and say more and more (Danish spoken at normal speed sounds like a different language so I haven't mastered interpreting spoken Danish yet). Mentally I think I am doing fine, of course it's not fun to be sitting in class all day as the one person who can't speak Danish but so long as I take that frustration out in the Gym after school, I can handle it. Today we toast the Rotary Club of Colombo North. The club meets at 12:30 PM every Tuesday.




