


VENUE RECCE

- The place comprises of 4 bedrooms upstairs where 28 girls stay.
- Ground floor has an IT room, security room, dining space, kitchen, storage and admin space
- The place was very clean and structured
- Children have a set daily route and a meal plan for the week.
- Their dining etiquettes were very disciplined

UNDERSTANDING THE OPERATIONAL MODALITY OF THE ORPHANAGE The entire orphanage is run with only 3 paid staff. One lady in charge of the wellbeing of the children, one lady looking after to cooking roles and another

lady looking after the cleaning roles

- There are 4 leaders elected by the children for each of the bedrooms.
 Though they are called leaders but they were actually room monitors.
- These 4 leaders report to a senior leader on day to day activity and grievance management.









STORYTELLING SESSION




BEST STORY THAT CAME FROM THE SESSION
