

BEGA ROTARY ART FAIR 2023 - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Exhibitors:

1. Exhibitors must be a resident of the Bega Valley Shire and be prepared to show evidence if required.

Entries:

2. Entries must be the original work of the artist and be available for sale. Include GST where applicable.
3. A maximum of 6 entries per artist will be accepted. If the number of entries exceeds the space available, entries will be selected for display by the organisers.
4. Types of art that can be accepted include painting, drawing, original prints (no reprints accepted) and a limited number of original ceramic pieces. Multi panel pieces will be accepted as one entry and must be priced for sale as one item. The whole work should not exceed the size limits.
5. Any side of an exhibit should not exceed 1.25m, including framing. If space allows, larger works may be considered.
6. Paintings, drawings and prints must have the artists name, title of exhibit, medium (e.g. acrylic, oil, watercolour, original print etc.) and sale price attached to the back of each exhibit. Ceramics must have the name of the artist and sale price attached to each piece. ie. a personal price tag.
7. All exhibits must be delivered finished, framed if required and ready for hanging if appropriate with a crosswire approx. one-third from the top.
8. Entries will be displayed at the organiser's discretion and a selection process may be necessary due to limited space and to ensure appropriateness of exhibits.

Fees:

9. An entry fee of \$5.00 will be payable for each exhibit entered.
10. All sales will be subject to a 20% commission to be used for the fund-raising activities of the Rotary Club of Bega. Artists are also encouraged to make a further donation from their sale proceeds.

Dates:

11. The Entry Form must be received no later than 5pm Friday 2 December 2022.

12. Exhibits to be delivered to Bega Showground Arts & Crafts building, Upper Street, Bega on Tuesday 17 January 2023 10am-4pm or Wednesday 18 January between 8.30am-12.30pm or by previous arrangement.
13. Public viewing of the Rotary Club of Bega Art Fair will be 20-21 January 2023 with an Opening Night and early-bird sale on the evening of 19 January 2023.
14. Unsold exhibits to be collected on Saturday 21 January 2023, 4pm-5pm or Sunday 22 January 2023, 10am-4pm or by previous arrangement. Identification may be required. If the exhibitor is unable to collect their work personally, organisers must be notified of the nominee details and identification will be required on collection.

General:

15. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage. Insurance of exhibits is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors shall be responsible for transport of exhibits to the venue as well as from the venue if unsold.
16. The organisers reserve the right to take images by photo or video during the Fair for marketing and promotion purposes.
17. Payment for exhibits sold will be by electronic transfer from the Rotary Club of Bega to the bank, as detailed by the exhibitor on the Entry Form, within 7 days of the closing date of the Art Fair.
18. The organising committee reserves the right to vary the conditions of entry and running of the event if needed for the proper and orderly conduct of the event.
