We covered a lot of ground.

Fiji Project. David Brawn, who heads the District Environmental Team, has asked for support in a project to install a solar system in a small Fiji School. Costs are estimated at \$45,000. Subject to Board approval, we will donate \$1,000.

Defibrillators for Banksia. We had applied for a District Foundation Grant of \$4,000. \$3,600 has been granted—we will meet the balance.

Kiosk. Ken Brown has arranged a pretty comprehensive overhaul of the building. We need a working bee to paint the walls.

Kiosk Menu. We are trialling fish and chips—\$10.

Dinner Menu. The Golf Club dining room will be closed from 9th to 16th August. The Club will supply pizzas for our 9th meeting and will open the kitchen for the 16th.

Pre School veggie garden. The chook run that we built in Rohan's year remains in good order but the three vegetable beds need renewing. Alternative maerials for replacing the beds are being investigated—working bees to construct them will be needed.
