Notes on Friday's Carers Meeting

President Shirl provided an agenda and a collection of articles on successful Carer Accommodations at Regional Hospitals. She had added her thoughts on organisations and individuals who might be approached to help in fund raising.

Fifteen people attended, including seven Rotarians from Moruya, three from Narooma and one (President Matthew Thomas) from Batemans Bay.

There was general agreement that Carers Accommodation at the new hospital was highly desirable, and that its provision is a worthwhile community project.

An organisation dedicated to the project is needed, an Incorporated body provisionally called CAREH. As shown in Shirl's notes, Councillor Rob Pollock agreed to Chair this body. At this stage no Treasurer is nominated as no funds are as yet dedicated to the task.

So this was a substantial step forward. The next meeting is on Friday 30th September when we hope to have commitments from non Rotarians prepared to work in one of the several areas identified by President Shirl to get the show on the road.
