Homelessness

On 27 July 2021, we had a presentation by Anglicare which included their inability to cope with the numbers seeking shelter. Pauline spoke of the smell of poverty. This lead to conversations with the Shire and last week Rhonnie was able to give us a summary of how Council had responded.

It was very impressive. Working with Homeless Support Services (SHSS) during the winter months, access to hot showers and free laundry services were needed. Council installed two PayWave Kiosk's at Moruya and Narooma laundromat facilities, and paid for a commercial dryer at the St. Vincent de Paul Society support centre in Batemans Bay. All three town centres now have facilities to wash and dry clothes.

Council leased and installed two portable shower and hot water units at the North Head Camp to service the 50 homeless people reported to be living on site. This arrangement will end this December.
