Jan reports:

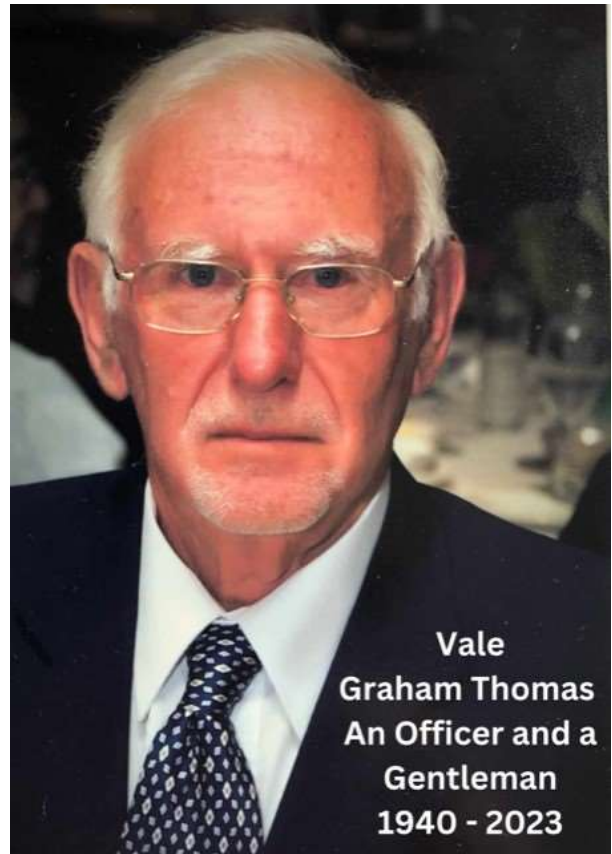
