Progress Report from the Museum

Hi Chris and Derek,

A report on progress on the veranda renovation follows:

The team has stabilised the support posts. When the verandah decking was removed sections on several joists were found to have rotted. Some new timber had to be purchased and is ready to be installed.

The bearers and joists were put in place on Monday ready for the decking next Monday 21 August. The attached photo below was taken as the team was starting to lay the bearers.

The estimated budget for the work was finally \$2288 and the actual cost has been \$2327 above budget. All materials now on hand and should be completed within the month. MDHS will cover any difference between the Rotary Moruya contribution and the actual cost.

We also intend putting in place signage acknowledging the work of our volunteers and the very generous donation from Rotary.

Tea for Meals on Wheels Volunteers

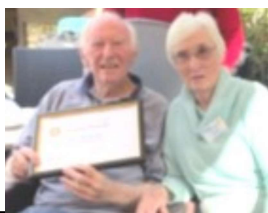
