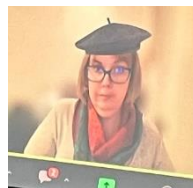

**Rotary Information:** Ron explained to members how the Rotary emblem evolved.

The Rotary Wheel, unchanged since 1924 was redesigned many times in the early years of the organization. A Rotary club of Chicago emblem that featured a wagon wheel influenced early logos of other clubs and Rotary International. Since the original concept of the Rotary wheel in 1905, several redesigns and differences of opinion occurred.

In 1921 a design created by Rotarian Oscar Bjorge was formally adopted. It was an emblem with 6 spokes and 24 cogs. The number of teeth and spokes was intended to reflect a real, working gear wheel. They did not reflect any specific aspect of Rotary. By 1924 the design was modified to include a keyway.

For many years the wheel stood alone as our logo. In 2013 Rotary expanded the official logo to include the "Rotary" next to the wheel. Today, the emblem has evolved to a simple yellow wheel with "Rotary International" included.



The Rotary wheel remains our mark of excellence.
