Rotary Information: Ron - Why the Rotary year begins 1 July.

Rotary's first fiscal year began the day after the first convention ended on 18 August 1910. The 1911-12 fiscal year also related to the convention, beginning with the first day of the 1911 convention on 21 August. The next August the Board of Directors ordered an audit of the International Association of Rotary Club's finances. The auditors recommended that the organization end its fiscal year on 30 June to give the secretary and treasurer time to prepare a financial statement for the convention and board. The executive committee agreed and, in April 1913, designated 30 June as the end of the fiscal year.

Guest Speaker: Kacy Baumann from Oz Harvest was introduced by Sandy Hoffmann. Kacy was a medical technologist for 30 years. She now volunteers for OzHarvest in Brisbane each week.

⁽Founded by Ronni Kahn AO in 2004 after noticing the huge volume of food going to waste, OzHarvest quickly grew to become Australia's leading food rescue organisation. Food is at our core, saving surplus food from ending up in landfill and delivering it to

charities that help feed people in need. We are committed to halving food waste by 2030, inspiring and influencing others to do the same, and transforming lives through education.'

Ronni Kahn started with 1 truck and currently has 600 paid staff and 4000 volunteers. There are 9 refigerated trucks in Brisbane that are used to collect 900 kg of food each day. Fresh and cooked food is distributed around the city. OzHarvest also sells corporate cooking courses to educate people and feed others. OzHarvest goes to community markets & schools.

Kacy asked questions about what happens in our area. What does Woolies, cafes, etc do? Others? What can we do? Are there already collections? The local Pantry collects/buys food from some of the local food suppliers and Food Bank. Following health regulations is challenging. They are

closely adhered to.


- 11 April Special meeting voting on the updated Constitution proxy forms available for those who cannot attend.
