
- Website

 - Lee provided an update concerning the Round Rock Fourth of July Parade, where we have the opportunity to participate as members of the Service Coalition of Round Rock. He has secured a number of plush toys to hand out to the kids along the route and would be grateful for any support any of the members can provide. A number confirmed their availability for the event.

Fund Raising

- Potential to host a 5K run at Old Settlers Park
 - Lee reported that with the redevelopment work taking place at Old Settlers Park, there may be an opportunity to once again host a 5K run at the park, as pedestrian traffic and vehicular traffic will be separated. While there won't be the holiday lights to encourage participation, it may be worth thinking about a possible hook to stage such an event in the future, as early as late 2025, but more likely 2026, as this was a good fundraiser for us.
