Audry Dudley is the Tourism Coordinator for Wells County Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development.

Audry was born and raised in Bluffton and did a college internship with the Chamber of Commerce and Bluffton NOW where she helped reinvigorate the Farmers Market, among other things. She has since joined the paid staff as the tourism coordinator.

Audry explained that tourism isn't just what you normally think of associated with vacations, but also includes people coming to Wells County for sporting events, staying in a hotel for a family event such as a wedding, camping trips, and anything else that brings people to our county. Three things important to our visitor economy are to embrace both the tourists and the residents, focus on the place and not the person, and

improving the quality of the place. This involves looking at what attracts visitors, our infrastructure, and services that cater to the needs of visitors and residents.

One way that we could improve tourism and marketing efforts for Wells County is an Innkeepers Tax. This is NOT a tax for residents or businesses but is a visitors' fee. Currently we have had some funding to help with tourism, the website, the books, marketing and branding but we need something more sustainable. Out of the 92 counties in Indiana we are one of only 13 that do NOT have this tax in place. Using the number of rooms available in Wells County and the average cost per room it has been calculated that at 50% capacity for the year the visitors fee could bring in approximately \$93,000 per year.

Currently Audry is focusing on revitalization, community events, arts and culture, branding, website (visitwellscounty.com) and social media. Any events that we have going on in the community can be submitted to Audry at <u>visitwellscounty@gmail.com</u> for promotion.
