Rotarians In Service For Equality (RISE) was founded in July 2022 as a cause-based Rotary club focused on issues and concerns of the LGBTQIA+ community. Membership is open to all who share this interest. Current members reside in Southern California, Phoenix, Denver, Houston, and Florida.

RISE Mission Statement

"We exist to foster acceptance, inclusion, and diversity and to RISE above: by providing services, opportunities, and education to our members, the LGBTQIA+ community and the global community at large."

2022 Highlights

- RISE established initial bylaws, articles of incorporation, and aligned with Rotary International and District 5280 requirements, created a social media presence and a website.
- RISE distributed its first community grant in support of SPY (Safe Place for Youth). SPY provides street outreach, case management, education, employment health and wellness, and housing services to Los Angeles area youths that are homeless or at risk to being homeless.
- RISE held its first fundraiser, a virtual screening of the movie, *CURED*, attended by nearly 100 people, raising nearly \$3,700 for projects in multiple RISE member geographies.
- RISE hosted guest speakers from organizations across RISE's membership area including The Lavender Project, Rainbow Labs, Kaiser Foundation and others.
