"2025 - State of the Non-Profit Sector"

Jessica Hubbard, Exec. Dir., Yolo Comm. Foundation, and Carolina Valverde, YCF Program Manager.



We work in Yolo Co., founded in 2001, to support non-profits. Our three main pillars: to inspire giving, to support philanthropists, and to serve non-profits. We currently have over 500 funds with \$15 million in assets, about a third set up by governments or non-profits as special or reserve funds. This is a good deal larger than the \$4.5 million we had in 2019.

We gave out some \$2 million in grants last year. We serve non-profits with training and leadership courses, including panels, workshops and group discussions.

We prepare a "State of the Non-Profit Report," looking at the trends across the County. Unfortunately, many non-profits are facing staffing and funding problems. 50% report less than 6 months of operating reserves. Last year it was 30%. Staff burnout is a real issue. But we are working on Sustainability approaches to strengthen our non-profits, to better adapt and grow!
