What you need to know “in a nutshell”

- D5010 has a committee to help screen and support candidates
- Candidates can work towards a Master’s degree (15-24 months/average award \$75 K) or a Professional certificate (1 year/average award \$11K) in designated locations
- Study would begin in 2022
- Most expenses are paid by TRF including tuition & fees, room & board, RT transportation and any internship/field study expenses.
- The district gets very few candidates for this wonderful opportunity! Word of mouth has been the best source for recommendations. **We NEED your referrals.**
- Rotarians and family members are not eligible.
- The district has a direct benefit when people come back to do their work here.
- The best process is to take the eligibility quiz on line through Rotary, then **contact a local club or the district committee before applying with RI.** Since this is highly competitive, the local committee can help strengthen candidate applications before they are submitted.
- Deadline to apply within the district is April 20, 2021
