This is a critical year for the polio eradication programme. Coming off the lowest case count in history in 2017, we begin the new year with the momentum to make polio eradication a reality. In Pakistan and Afghanistan, where a period of typically lower polio transmission is starting, the programme is seizing a prime opportunity for progress by strengthening efforts to reach vulnerable children and track polio in the environment

Country Updates (as of January 31st, 2018).

since the January Newsletter

- **Update:** An additional case in Afghanistan has been confirmed in January with onset in December. This brings the 2017 count in Afghanistan to 14 and the global count to 22.
- Globally:

Afghanistan: One new case of polio (WPV1) in has been confirmed during January.

Pakistan: No new cases have been detected since 14-Nov-17.

Nigeria: No new cases have been detected since 20-Aug-16.

No new cases of vaccine-derived polio have been detected in **Syria** (last case 20-Sep-17) or the **Congo** (24-Nov-17).
