For the last several years, we have developed a Powerpoint presentation (visual only) that we use as a backdrop during the conference, while the meals and other breaks are taking place. The presentation is then available on our webpage for all who want to see just what we do in Rotary D5040! It will also be available to any clubs who may wish to use it at their own events as a backdrop.

I would like to continue this tradition, so I would ask you to supply me with appropriate projects that I can include in the presentation. The format of each slide will be common, so please send medetails as follows:

1. A .jpg photograph that shows the project – during development or as completed or whatever you think most appropriate to illustrate the scope and volunteers involved.
2. No more than 2 photos per project, please, and no more than 3 projects per club. These can be Local or International projects.
3. A **short** text message to explain the project.
4. Don't forget to have a title that includes your Club name! You'd be amazed at how often that is not included!!
5. Each slide will show for about 15 - 20 seconds and be on a continuous loop – so **keep the text short and snappy!** I attach a few examples of what it should look like. Just send me the picture and the text – I will arrange the formatting.

This is a great opportunity to show off your club's service projects to a wide audience, both at the Conference as well as through our websites. I know we have hundreds of these in the District.

Many thanks to you all for your support. Please send me these details as soon as possible – but no later than the end of March, 2012.
