PROCESS FOR SELECTING CANDIDATES

(May 2020)

Governing Legislation:

RI Bylaws ("RIB") Article 12.010

RI Code of Policies ("RIP") Article 19.030

Process

1. The five most recent past district governors who are members in good standing in a club in the district shall serve on the nominating committee.
2. The governor shall invite clubs to submit their suggestions for nominations to the nominating committee.
3. Candidates must be suggested by clubs or by the District Nominating Committee.
4. Clubs may only submit one candidate, who must be a member of that club. The submitted candidate must be chosen by a resolution adopted at a regular club meeting and certified by the secretary.
5. Nominating committee will meet and interview all candidates that meet the required qualifications of Governor Nominee as stated in RI Bylaws.
