**DOING GOOD IN THE WORLD**

Example of Funding Model

With matched dollars, your \$10,000 USD investment results in a \$35,000 project.

Club (s) funds + 5% admin fee = **\$10,000**  
 District (DDF) match club = \$10,000  
 World Fund match 50% of club = \$ 5,000  
 World Fund match 100% of District = \$10,000

**Total funds available = \$35,000**

## Global & District Grants - Qualification Requirements

Clubs must qualify to receive Foundation Funds.

The process ensures that clubs are aware of all Rotary requirements and provides clubs with the tools needed to complete the on-line applications.

- ◇ Attend a **Grant Management Seminar** - **Upcoming seminars: January 19, 2019 - BC, February 16, 2019 - WA**
- ◇ Two club members must attend each year
  - ◇ One must be the President Elect
  - ◇ The second should be the club grant writer or the grant writer in training .
- ◇ Complete and submit a signed club MOU
- ◇ Clubs are qualified for one year
- ◇ Members that attend the Grant Management Seminar and sign a MOU are qualified for three years
