

- Make two copies of your student's documentation/insurance- one to keep, one for host family.
- Set up cell service-phone
- Begin student stipend and make sure checks are written each month.
- Open two bank accounts
 - One for emergency funds
 - One for personal use

A SUCCESSFUL FIRST MONTH FOR YOUR STUDENT (CONT.):

- Enroll in school
- Obtain an ASB card/ School Counselor appointment/ clubs and sports sign-ups
- Make sure the classes your student is signed up for are appropriate. Monitor their progress- most schools have a "parent portal" to monitor grades and attendance.
- Bus or transportation pass if needed
- Arrange for extracurricular transportation to sports/activities (this is a great way to get individual Rotarians participating!).
