**International Service Recognition (Club size: 1-35 = small, 36-70 = medium, 71+ = large)**

**Complete at least 6 (large Club) – 5 (medium) – 4 (small) of the following: Number Completed:**

<b>1</b>	Participate in one <b>new</b> International Project. (Projects where at least one member and/or Rotaractors traveled to the site for hands-on experience will count as meeting 2 requirements). Explain if completed:
<b>2</b>	Participate in a new or existing International Project <b>with another Club and/or District</b> . (Projects where at least two members traveled to the site for hands-on experience will count as meeting two requirements) Explain if completed:
<b>3</b>	Submit a Global Grant application to support an International Project. Multi-Club, multi-district projects will count as meeting 2 requirements. Explain if completed:
<b>4</b>	Participate in a Polio Eradication awareness and fundraising campaign in your community. Funds raised and campaign highlights will be acknowledged at a District Event. Explain if completed:
<b>5</b>	Present a program on the Rotary Foundation (TRF) to the entire Club and attain Rotary Foundation Annual Programs Fund giving of a minimum \$100 per capita (per capita average may include Club contribution). Explain if completed:
<b>6</b>	Nominate a qualified Peace Scholarship candidate (long program or short program). Explain if completed:
<b>7</b>	Post a photo and story of your International project at <a href="http://www.GetRotary.org">www.GetRotary.org</a> and the D5240 Facebook page. Explain if completed:
<b>8</b>	Hands on participation in an International project site/ Club/ district or NID Explain if completed:
<b>9</b>	2 members (small Club); 4 members (mid-sized Club); 6 members (large Club) register for the 2014 RI Convention in Sydney Australia. 10% of members and spouses/partners register (counts as 2) Explain if completed:
<b>10</b>	Two members attend D5240 STEPS Conference Explain if completed:
<b>11</b>	Conduct a joint International Service project with your Interact or Rotaract Club (s). (Also counts for New Generations/Youth) Explain if completed:
<b>12</b>	Schedule D5240 International Service Director Max Copenhagen to speak to your Club. Explain if completed:
<b>13</b>	If not submitting a Global Grant proposal, participate in a Multi-Club Global Grant project Explain if completed:
<b>14</b>	Established OTHER International Service activities unique to your Club
