* The First Place Winner at District level is invited and expected to deliver his or her performance at the Rotary District 5280 Conference May 4, 2023.

Contestants may compete in more than one Art, but must notify the Pageant of the Arts Chair, Agnes Lewis, ajlewis7@gmail.com so that performance times may be coordinated.

Performance order is determined by random selection. The Contest Chair may make adjustments to accommodate special circumstances.

If a contestant is not present at the beginning of the contest, he/she may be disqualified, at the discretion of the Contest Chair. The decision of the contest Chair is final.

Contests will be judged by a panel of judges who are experts in their fields.
