

ROTARY CLUB INSTRUCTIONS

ART CONTEST

CLUB LEVEL COMPETITION INSTRUCTIONS

- Before any contestant can participate in the District-level competition on April 13, they must first compete in a club-level contest.
- Each student competing at the club level should complete the "Contestant Registration & Consent Form" (page 3 of this document) and return to their sponsoring Rotary Club.
- Rotary Clubs should retain a copy of completed registration forms, which will be helpful in completing the online application (see next section).
- Rotary clubs send their winning contestant from their club-level contest (only one student per category) to advance to the District-level competition on April 13, 2024.

DISTRICT LEVEL COMPETITION INSTRUCTIONS

Rotary Clubs: Please complete the steps below ONLY for students that are advancing to the District-level competition on April 13, 2024.

PAYMENT

- Rotary Clubs (not student) should send the entry fee for each contestant advancing to the District-level competition by **March 31, 2024.**
 - Small Clubs (20 members or less): \$90 per contestant
 - **Medium Clubs** (21-49 members): \$150 per contestant
 - Large Clubs (50+ members): \$200 per contestant

ONLINE APPLICATION

- Rotary Clubs (not student) must complete the online application for all contestants advancing to the District-level competition by **March 31, 2024.**

GENERAL CONTEST RULES

- District Finals, also known as the Pageant of the Arts, will be held **April 13, 2024** in person.
- Location: First United Methodist Church of Glendale, 134 N Kenwood St, Glendale, CA, 91206
- Time of each contest will be sent prior to the competition.
- Contestants must be currently enrolled in high school, home schooled, or an alternative program and of high school age.
- To qualify for the District Contest, the contestant must have won 1st place at a Rotary Club Art Contest prior to **March 31, 2024**, or be sponsored by a Rotary Club.
- Only one contestant for the Art Contest may be sent to the District Art Contest per Rotary Club.
- Art contestants may enter the other District Contests should they qualify and have the sponsorship of a Rotary Club. Separate Rules and Application apply.
- Prizes for each section of the competition:
 - 1st Place \$1,000.00 | 2nd Place \$500.00 | 3rd Place \$250.00
- The Contestant Registration & Parent/Guardian Consent Form must be signed by the contestant and their parent/guardian. This form must be returned to your Sponsoring Rotary Club.
- Your Sponsoring Rotary Club will retain a copy and email a copy to the Art Contest Chair.

ART SUBMISSION RULES

- Theme criteria: Artwork should focus on your interpretation of "Create Hope In The World", Rotary International's theme.
- All performances/presentations/exhibits must be live, in person at the venue.
- Art entry must be an original work, created by the contestant.
- The entry may be a painting, drawing, carving, or sculpture. Any other Art innovation may be considered but must be cleared by the Art Contest Chair.
- Dimensions: Art entry may not exceed 30 inches in any one direction, i.e. 30"H, 30"W and 30"D.
- Contestants must provide their own easels.
- An assistant may be used to help set up and take down the work.
- Contestants are expected to explain and comment on their work to the judges, including how it exemplifies the theme "Create Hope In The World". This presentation is part of the judging score.
- Judges are experts in their field. A Judging Rubric is used in evaluating contestants. The rubric is on Page 4 of this document.
