District Contest cash prizes for each Art:

**1<sup>st</sup> Place:      \$1,000.00**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Place:      \$500.00**

**3<sup>rd</sup> Place:      \$250.00**

**\*\*Prizes will be paid by check. Please allow 4 weeks for processing.**

Winners will be announced the day of the performance.

**TO QUALIFY**, you must win a contest at your local Rotary club, or be sponsored by the club, and advance to the District level.

**\*The First Place winner at District level is invited and expected to deliver his or her performance at the Rotary District 5280 Conference May 4-7, 2023.**

Contestants may compete in more than one Art, but must notify the Pageant of the Arts Chair, Agnes Lewis, [ajlewis7@gmail.com](mailto:ajlewis7@gmail.com) so that performance times may be coordinated.

Performance order is determined by random selection. The Contest Chair may adjust or accommodate for special circumstances.

If a contestant is not present at the beginning of the contest, he/she may be disqualified, at the discretion of the Contest Chair. The decision of the contest chair is final.

Contests will be judged by a panel of judges who are experts in their fields.

Performances may be photographed or filmed and posted on the Rotary5280.org website. Portions may be shown at the Rotary District 5280 Conference.
