Directions to Loyola Marymount University and Campus Parking - campus map included Parking is available in Lot A (Hannon Parking Lot)

Entrance to Loyola Marymount University is at the corner of Lincoln Blvd. and LMU Drive in the Westchester/Playa Vista area of Los Angeles.

LMU Drive is the third signal north of Manchester Ave. & the second signal south of Jefferson Blvd.

Once you have turned off of Lincoln Boulevard onto LMU Drive, stay on LMU Drive until it dead-ends. Then, turn right onto a one-way street, keeping to your left. The street will eventually curve to the left and you will reach a stop sign at the circular drive.

Turn right at the stop sign to Parking Lot A, just past the grassy park area on the right hand side. <u>Loading/Unloading</u> - For unloading contestant's materials, such as heavy/cumbersome art pieces, musical instruments, etc., use the circular drive on the left in front of the flagpoles. You will see the loading area, where cars can pull over for a short period of time.

Check-In - Once parked, please check-in in the Dunning Courtyard in the Burns Fine Arts Complex, which is located adjacent to the circular drive. Once you have checked-in, the Contest Chair will provide instructions and schedules for the order of contestant performances and competition.

Food and drink

Bottled Water and snacks will be available for contestants. Food and beverage may not be consumed inside the various competition facilities.

Note: If the student has any dietary restrictions, allergies, or specific needs, it is advised that they bring their own food items to the contest.

Attending Competitions

Guests may attend any of the competitions.

Contestants, observing their own competition schedule, may also attend any of the competitions and are encouraged to support the other contestants as audience members.

Competition Areas

Electronic Devices must be turned off during the performance period.

Photos and Videos

Each competition chair will announce if and when photos may be taken.

Entering & Exiting Competition Areas. No one will be allowed to enter or exit the competition facilities during a performance/presentation, with the exception of the art gallery. For the Dance, Music and Speech competitions, entry to and exit from the competition facility may only occur during the break between contestants.

Special Equipment

All contestants must provide whatever is needed for their performance/presentation.

Example, each Art Contestant must provide whatever is needed to display the contestant's entry.
