arks Foundation Calgary (PFC) is a non-profit organization dedicated to improving urban spaces for all Calgarians. Established in 1985, PFC has helped individuals, organizations, and communities create and enhance the city's parks and green spaces. For over 30 years, the Foundation has supported almost 130 community-led projects, awarded more than \$12 million in support of amateur sport initiatives, dedicated over 1,000 park benches throughout the city and built over \$200 million of parks and playgrounds infrastructure.

urrently in final stages of completion, the
Rotary/Mattamy Greenway is a 138 km network
of parks and pathways that will connect 55 communities
around the city of Calgary. Along the pathway, users will
find unique amenities such as specialty off-leash dog
areas, outdoor fitness parks, educational wetland
interpretive areas, boardwalks, unique play structures,
and memorial parks.

The challenge will be hosted online and through social media from Thursday, June 1st to Friday, September 1st. Registration will open in May. The first 150 People to register will be considered members of the '150 Green Team' and will receive an incentive.

Participants will continuously receive communication, including suggested routes, Greenway updates and tips to encourage their challenge completion.

Anyone can join the challenge, as an individual or a group.

People will be encouraged to share their progress through pictures via social media. Passports to track progress will be available at distributions points, events with challenge participants and will be available to download online.

n Saturday September 2, PFC will host four separate events in each quadrant of our culturally diverse city. We will host Canadians of all backgrounds and abilities to celebrate Canada's big milestone as well as the progress of the Rotary/Mattamy Greenway. These community events will include entertainment, arts and culture, and fun activities for the entire family. At each event, challenge participants will be honored and will receive a medal for their involvement, commitment and accomplishment.

We are expecting approximately 5,000 people to join the celebration and over 1,000 people to participate in the Summer Challenge. Through earned and social media, participation at city events, promotion the challenge and the main celebration, we anticipate to reach half the population in the city of Calgary.
