HOST Hospitality:



HOST HOSPITALITY (hosting guests for dinner either in a Rotarian's home or a larger venue hosted by a club) is the BEST event to welcome International guests to our city!

Host Hospitality is always one of the most sought after events as it gives Rotarians a super way to actually get to know us!!

Host Hospitality happens one night only – Monday, June 23, 2025. Dinner from 6 – 9 pm, guests should be home by 10:30 pm.

- Guests are randomly chosen for their designated home/venue, a great mix from various countries
- In home dinners are preferred by many visiting Rotarians smaller dinners for 4, 6, 8+ guests
- Meals can be anything from hamburgers to steak, chicken to tacos, salads, or any of your family favourites
- Larger group dinners are usually potluck with each local Rotarian bringing a dish, some of the best evenings are casual BBQ's in the backyard.
- Guests pay \$50.00 USD. These funds are used to cover transportation for larger groups to venues, or to out of town locations
 - This fee does **not** cover any expense for the dinner. Meal expenses are at the Club or member cost.
 - There is no subsidy to hosts from the Host Organizing Committee or RI.
 - Most in home dinners, whether small or mid size, will involve asking friends, family and other members to help by providing food and transporting the guests to your home. What is better than having someone pick you up for dinner and take you back to your hotel?
 - Calgary Transit is providing complimentary transportation anywhere in the city.. you may have your guests travel to an LRT station near to your home and they can be picked up there.
- For out of town clubs, within 1½ hours of Calgary, and larger dinners in Calgary, we will transport delegates by bus, there and back.
- Usually clubs in out of the city communities, host a large dinner with every member participating.
- Often small towns have hosted a walk about town after dinner so you can show off your community., how about Clubs outside of Calgary hosting a dinner at your meeting place or at a park named after your club? The possibilities are endless!

If you are a Club over 1 ½ hours away, you may be interested in hosting a dinner in Calgary. Let me know as I have several suggestions of restaurants/venues.

I am pleased to report that clubs outside of Calgary have been very positive about inviting delegates to their town for dinner! Specifics yet to be decided! And, several clubs and members in Calgary are exploring possibilities.. and, members are signing up!

I am in the process now of visiting clubs outside of Calgary and will soon be making plans with Calgary clubs. To sign up to host go to <u>www.rotarycalgary2025.org</u>
