Positive Peace Club Criteria

Form a Peace Committee:

Bring together two or more members who will promote and facilitate learning sessions about Rotary International's peacebuilding and positive peace pillars, in your local club and community.

Support the Rotary Peace Centers with an annual donation to the Rotary Foundation of (\$100, \$500, \$750, \$1000)*.

*Depending on club size and budget.









Select two or more of the following:

Engage in a peace education seminar or workshop.

Integrate peace into one or more service projects per year.

Apply a peacebuilder lens when selecting projects and programs.

Support a Peace Fellowship applicant.

Collaborate with Rotary members to build awareness of peace education.

Support other peacebuilding groups through participation.
