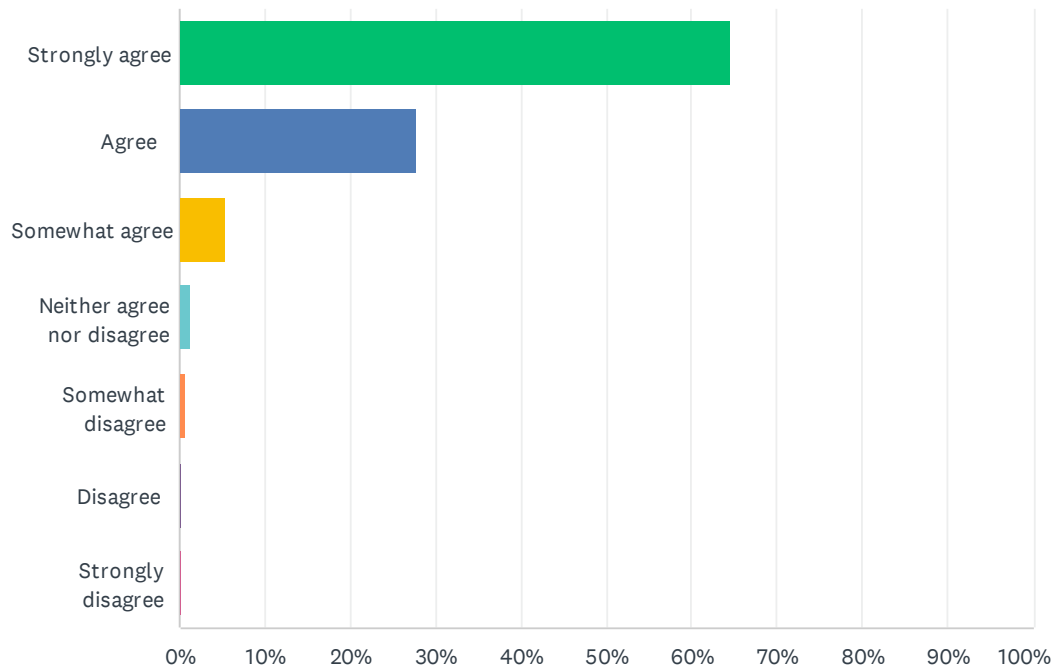

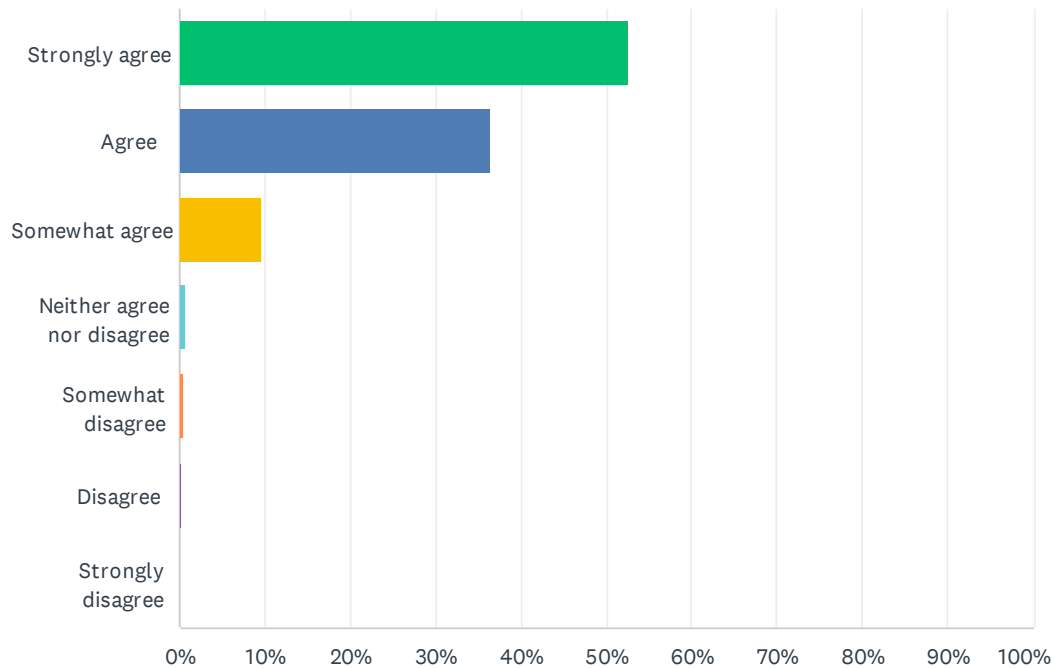

## Q2 I feel that Rotary allows me to make a difference in my community

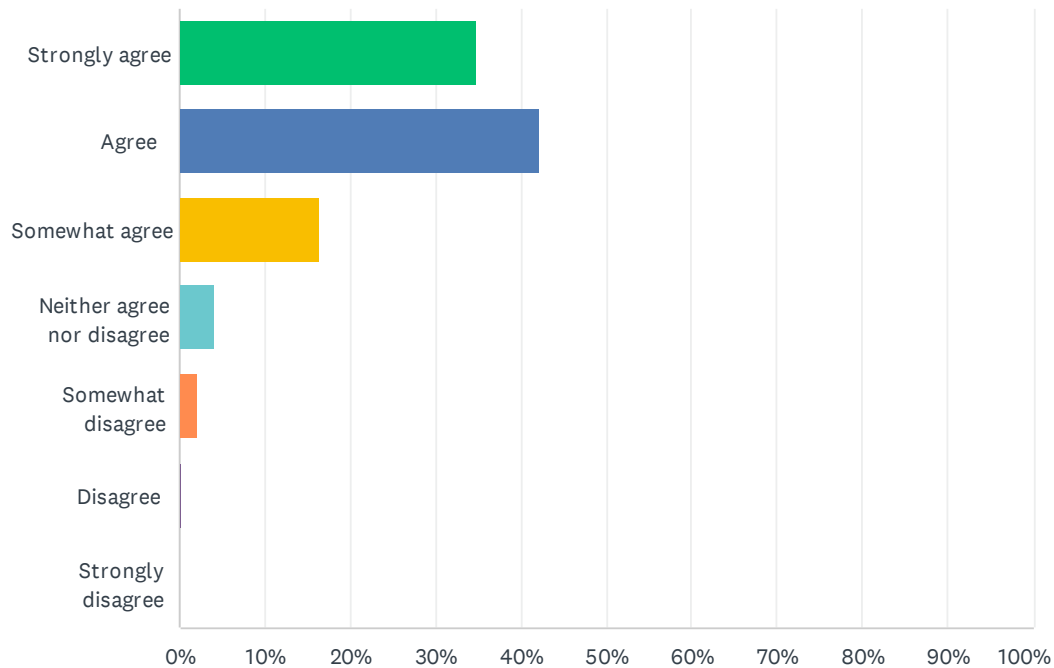

## Q3 I receive a good return on the investment of TIME I give to Rotary

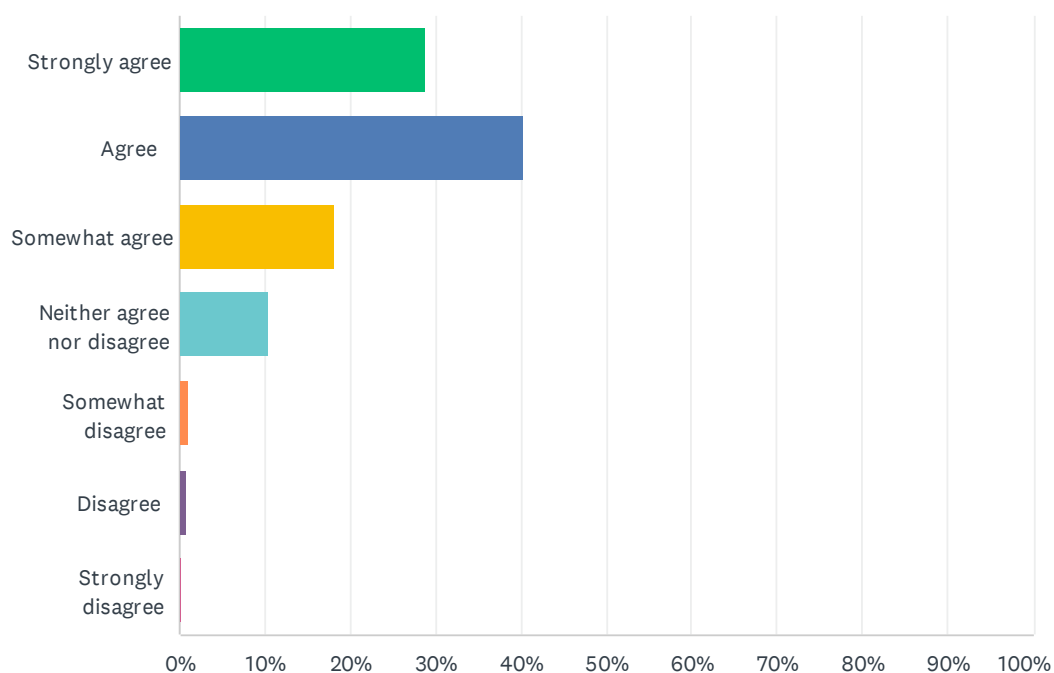

## Q4 Through Rotary, I make a difference internationally

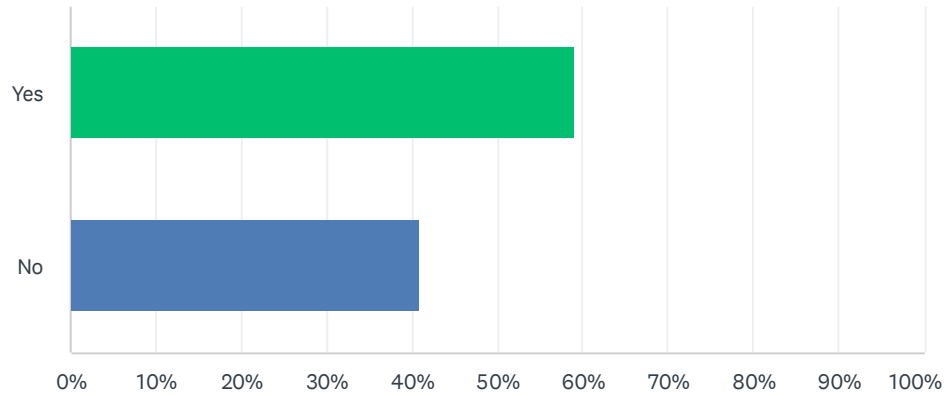

## Q5 In the past year, I have invited a guest to one of my Club's regular meetings, or social event

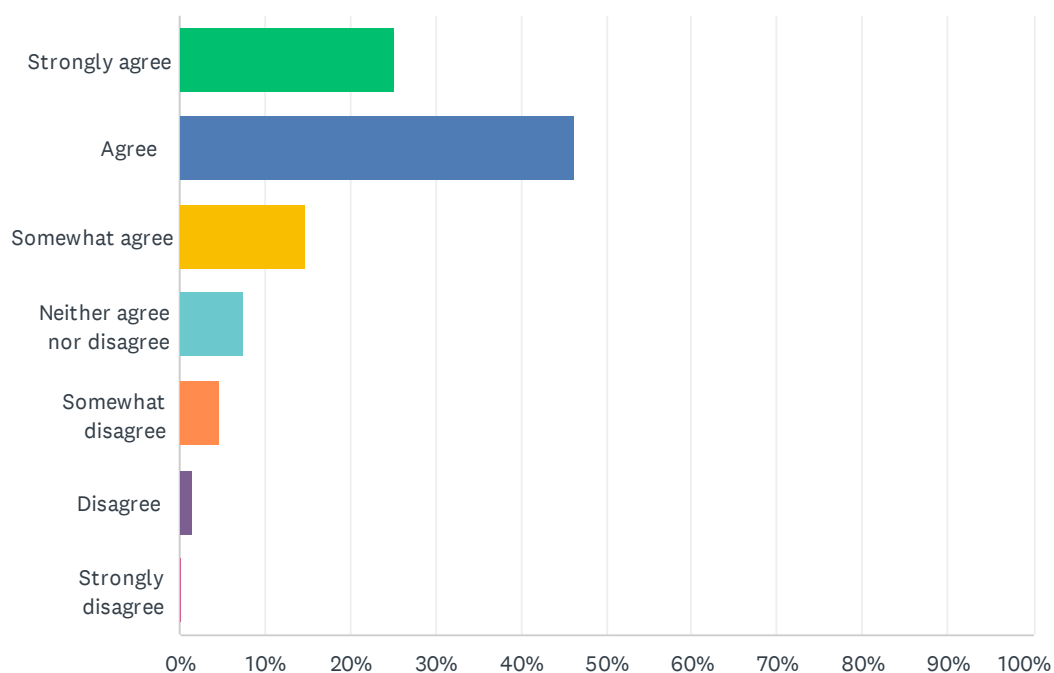

## Q6 I receive good value for the amount of MONEY I spend in Rotary

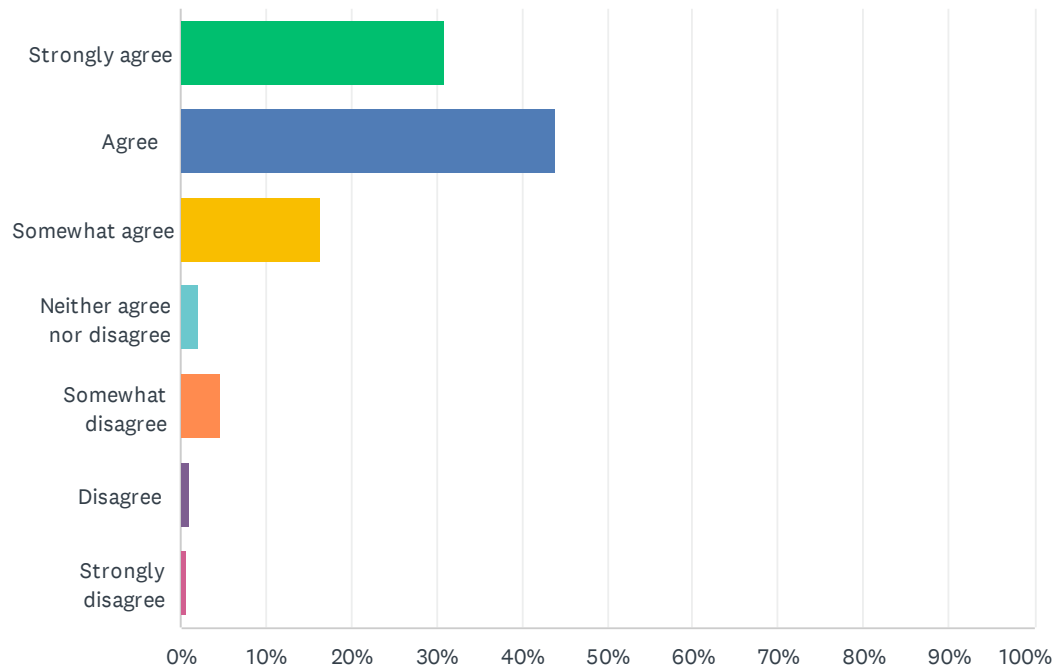

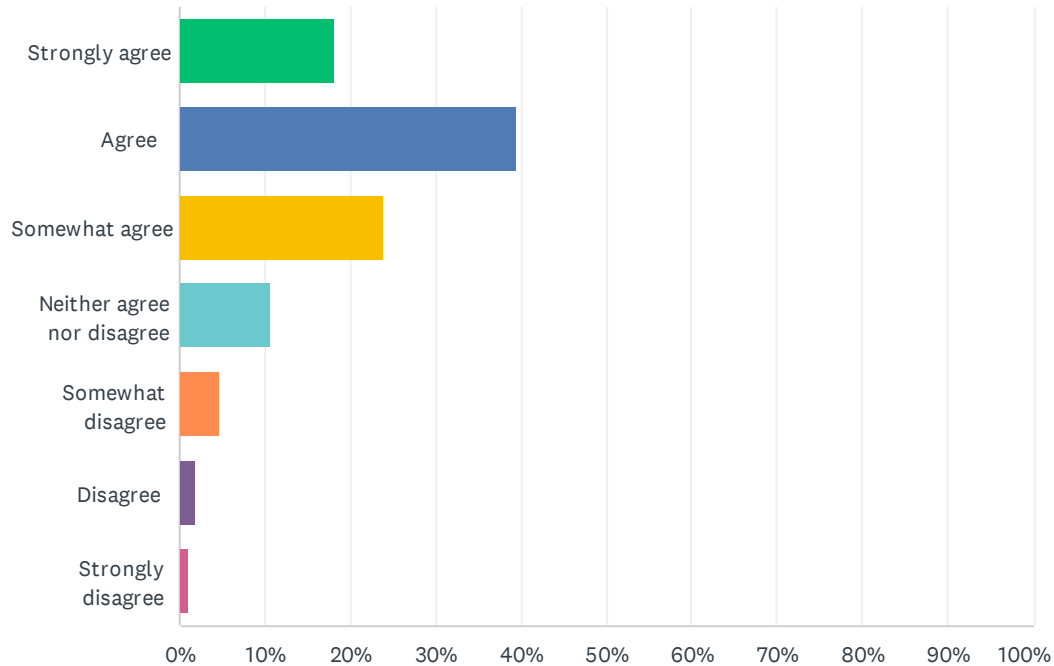

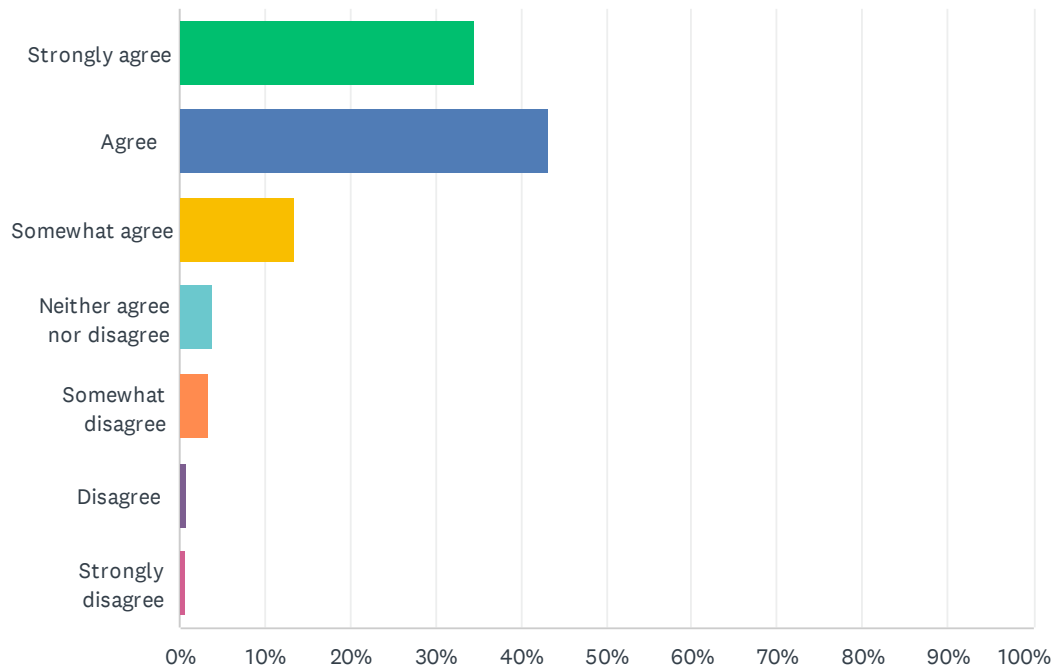

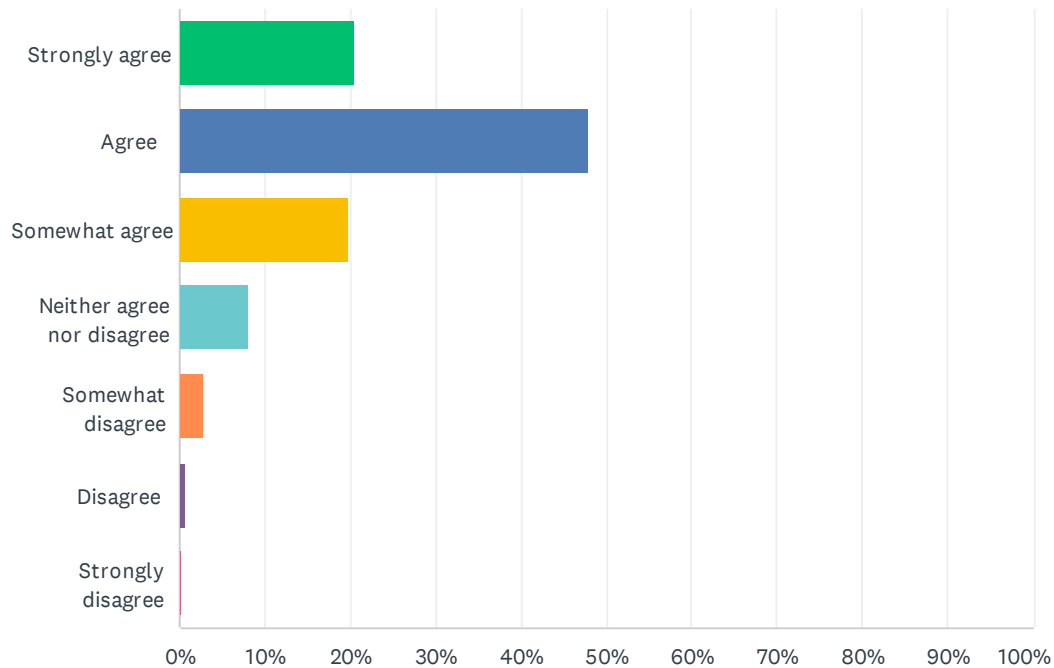

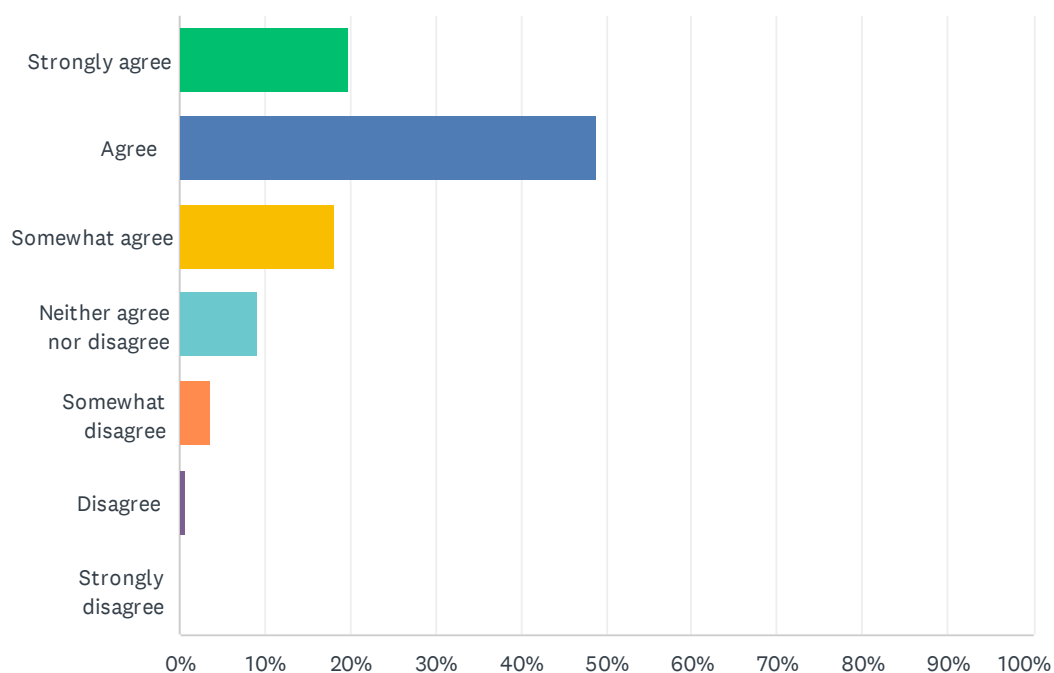

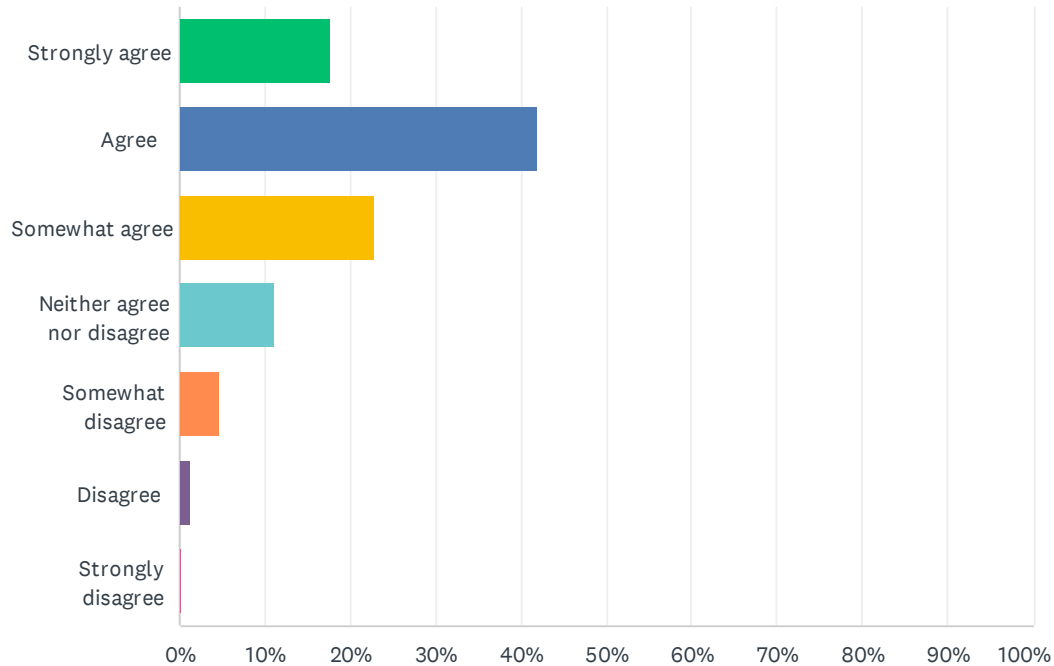

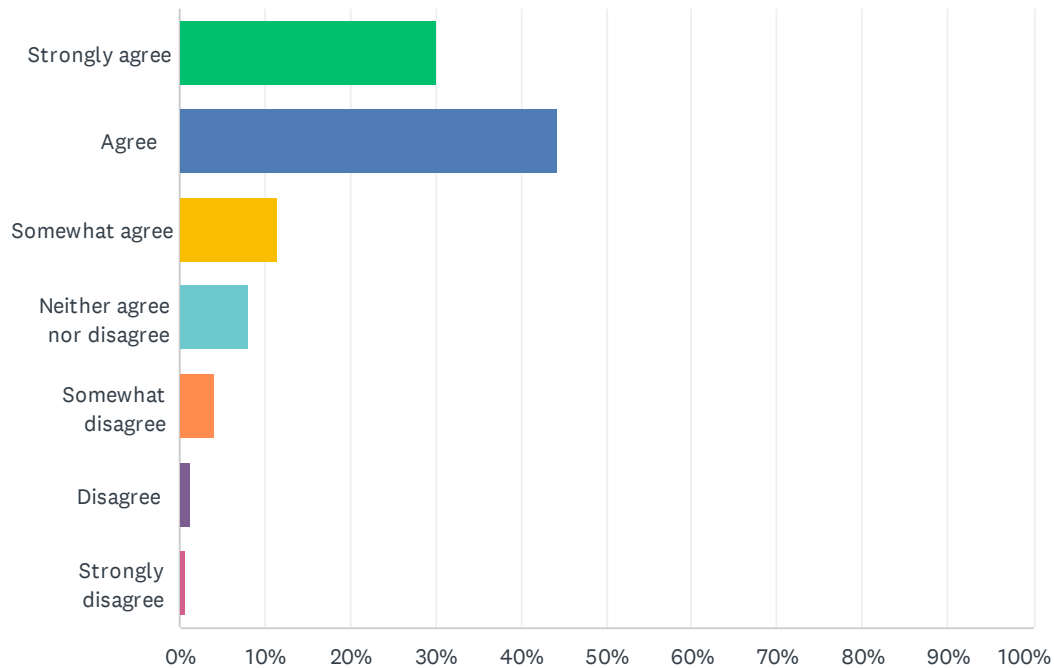

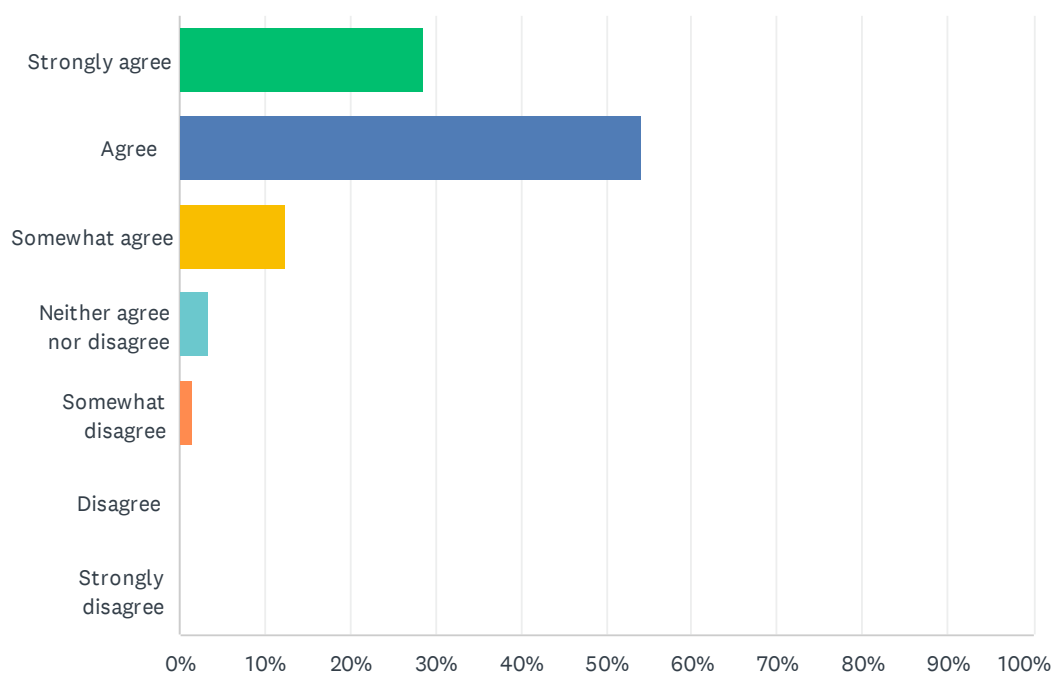

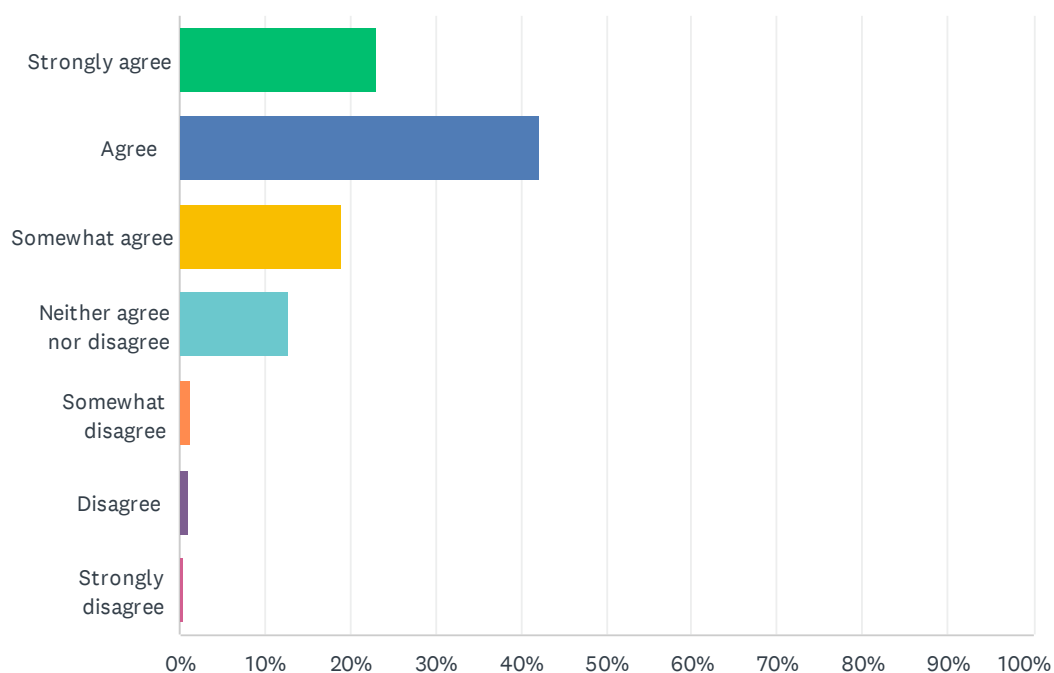

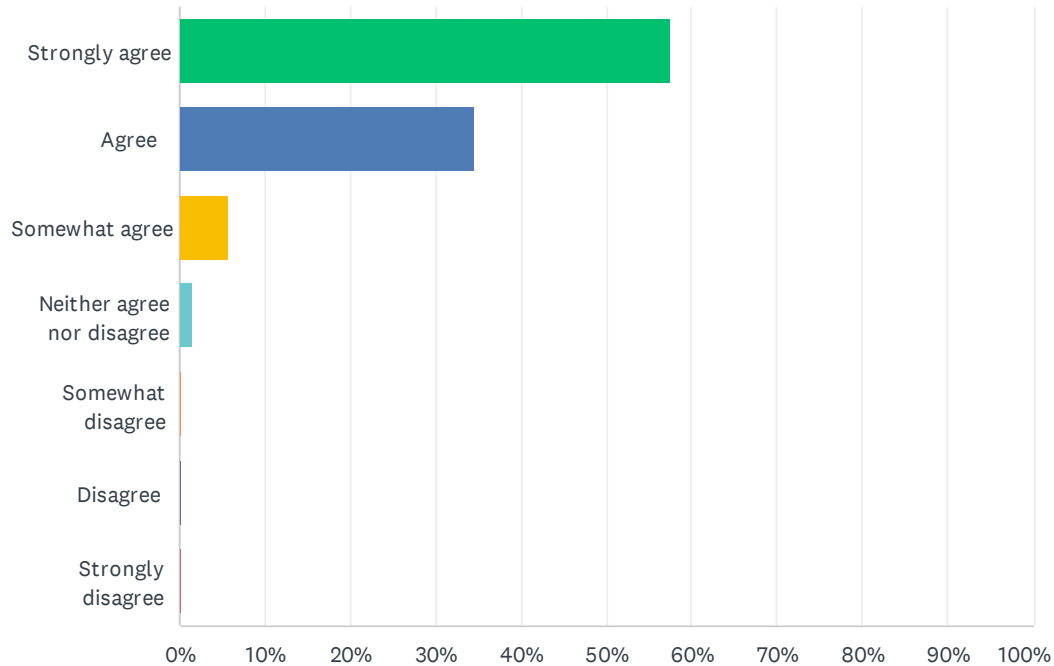

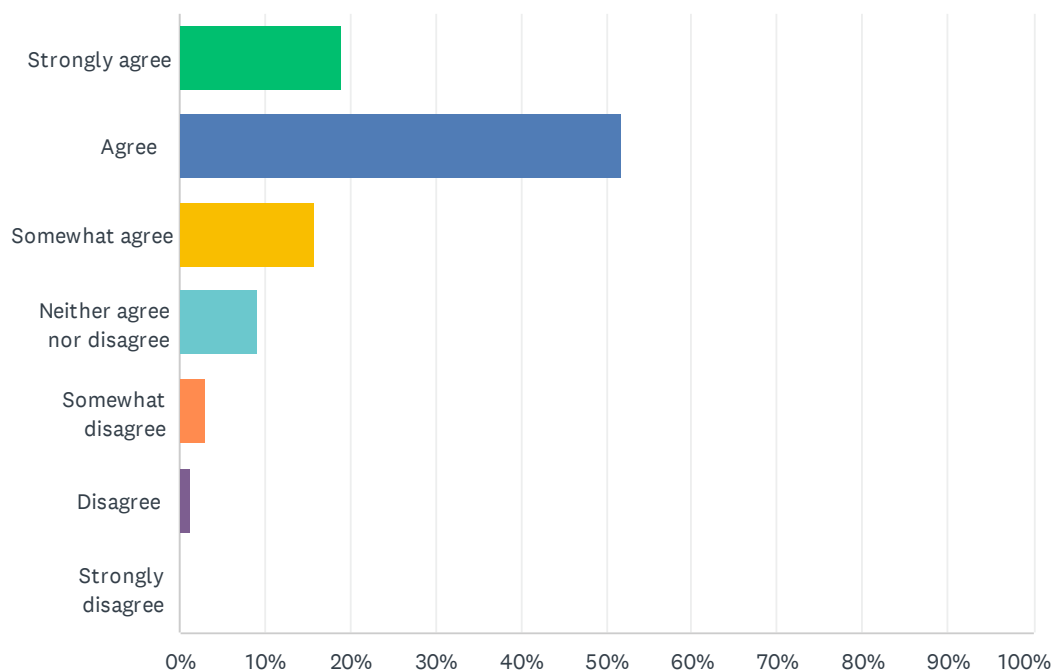

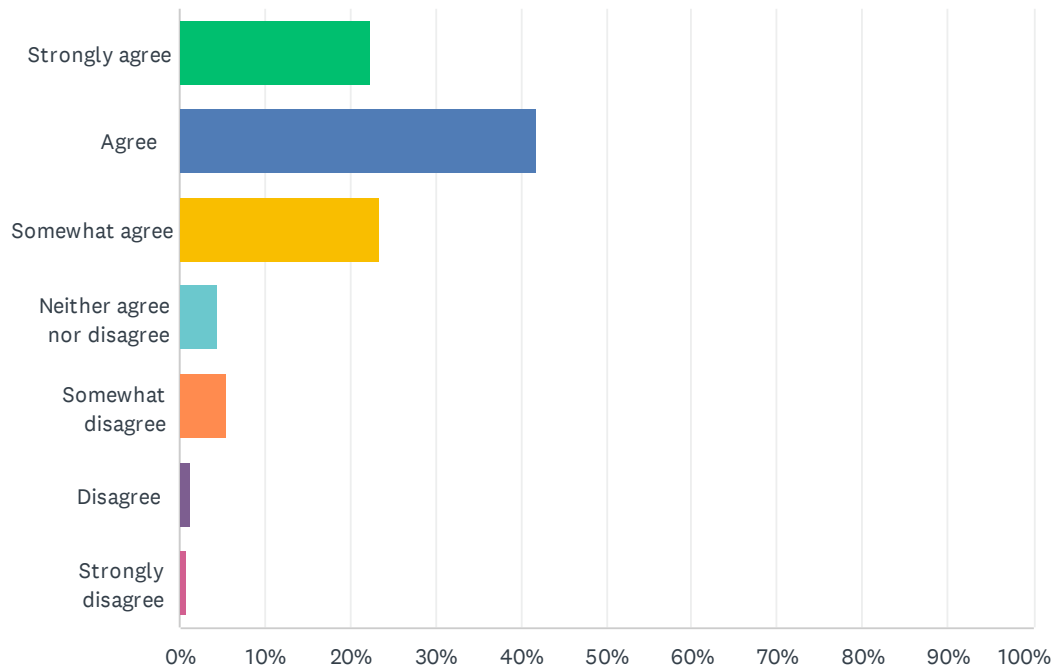

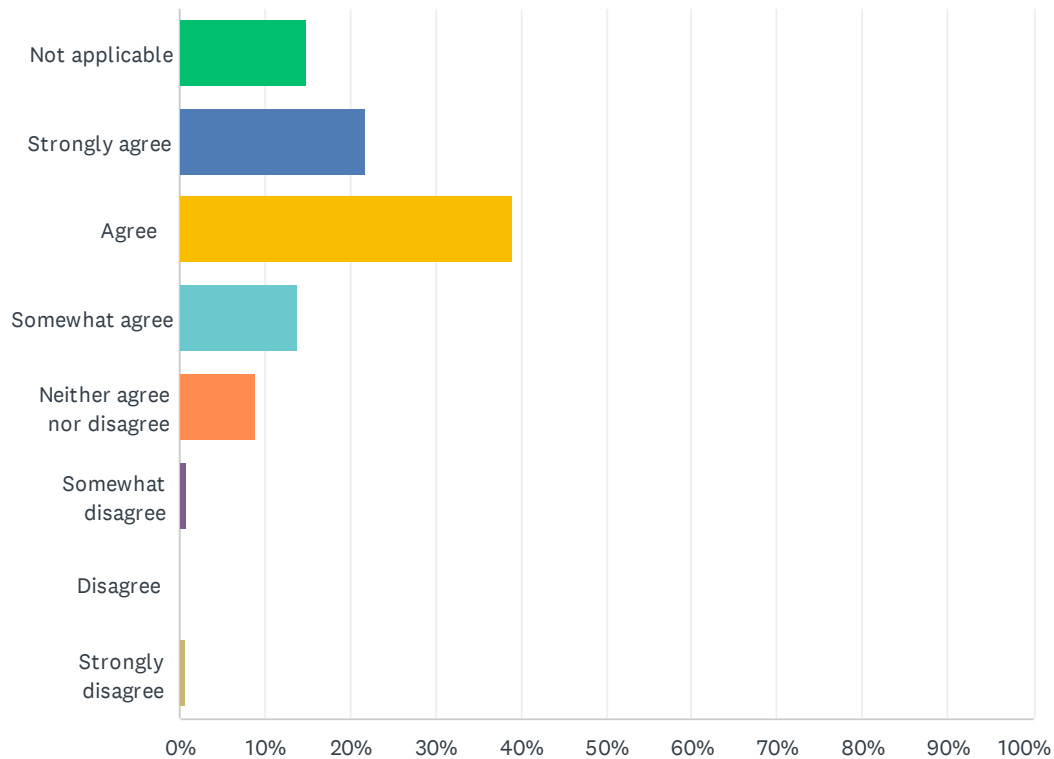

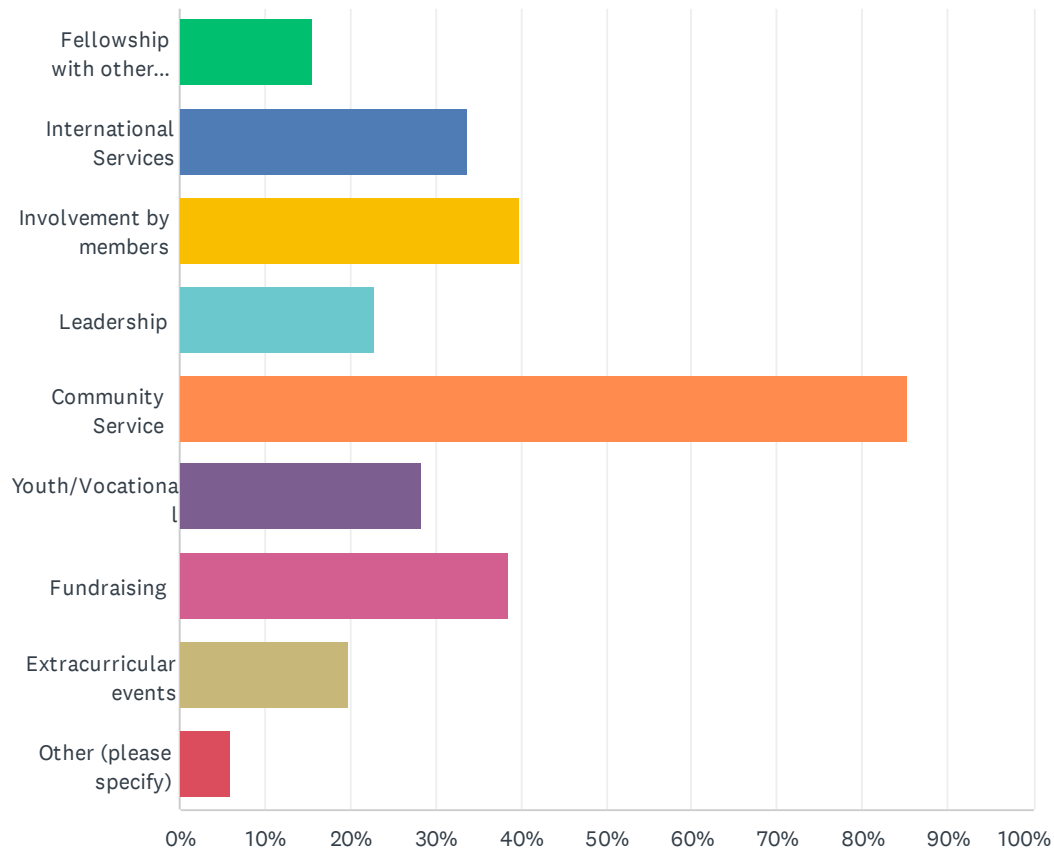

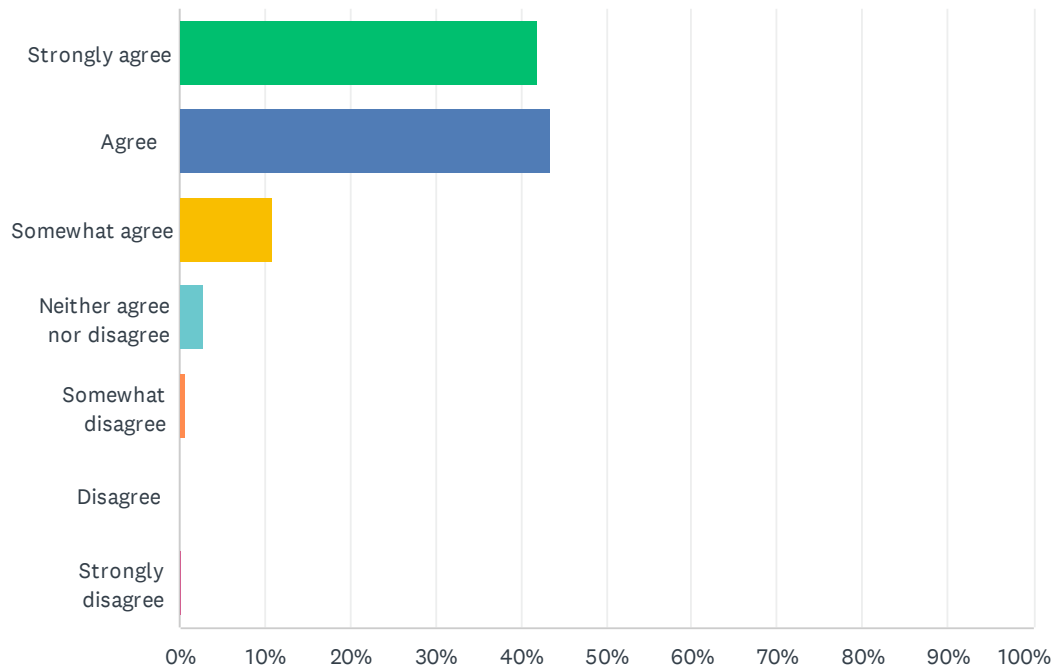

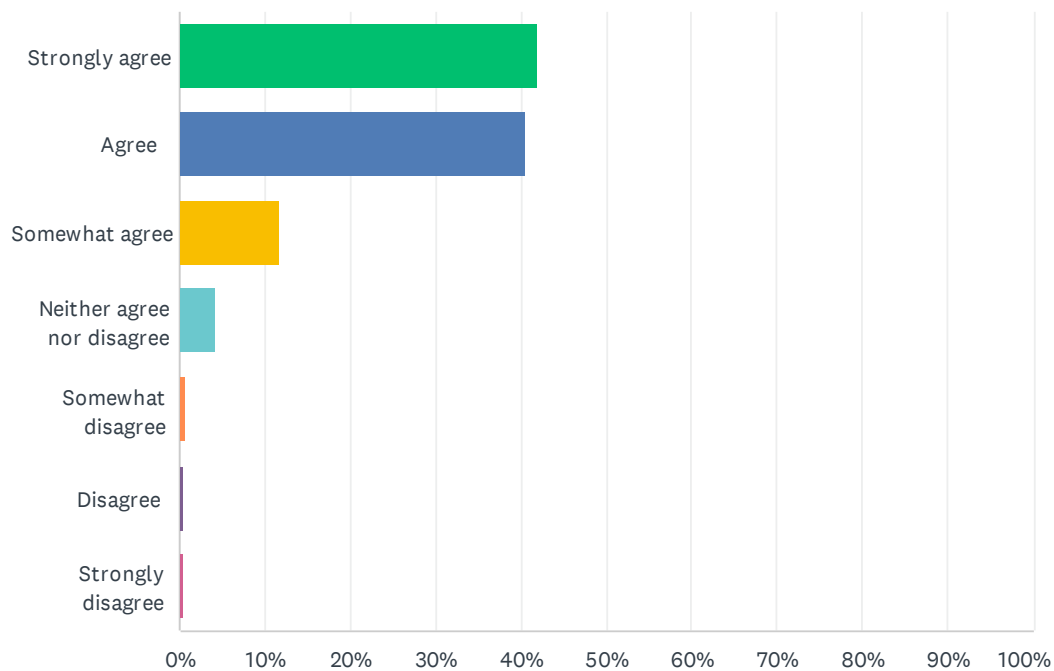

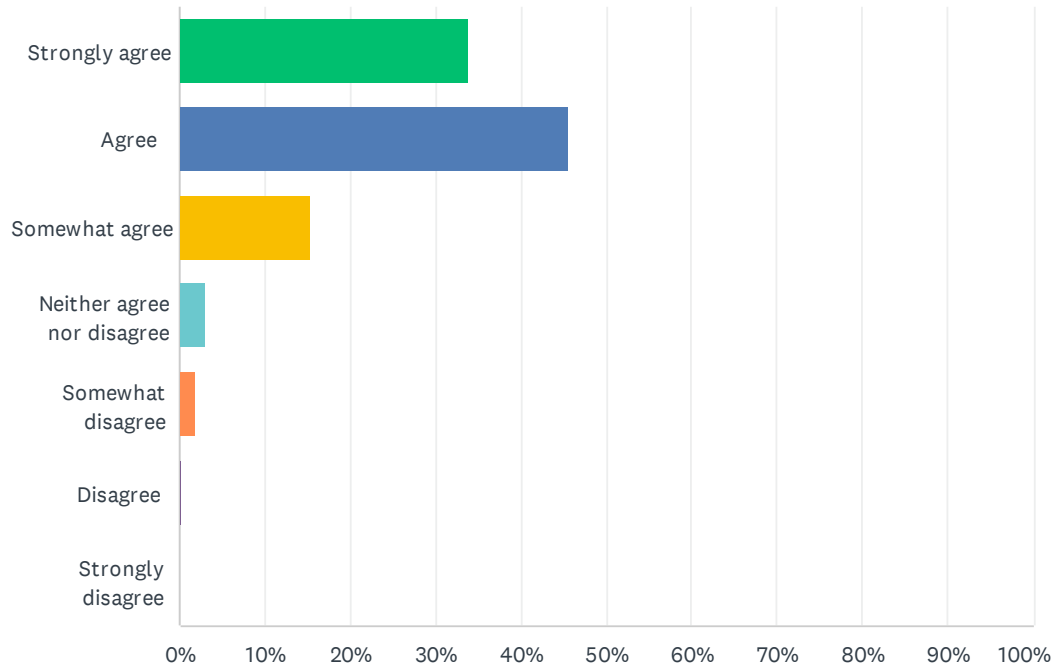

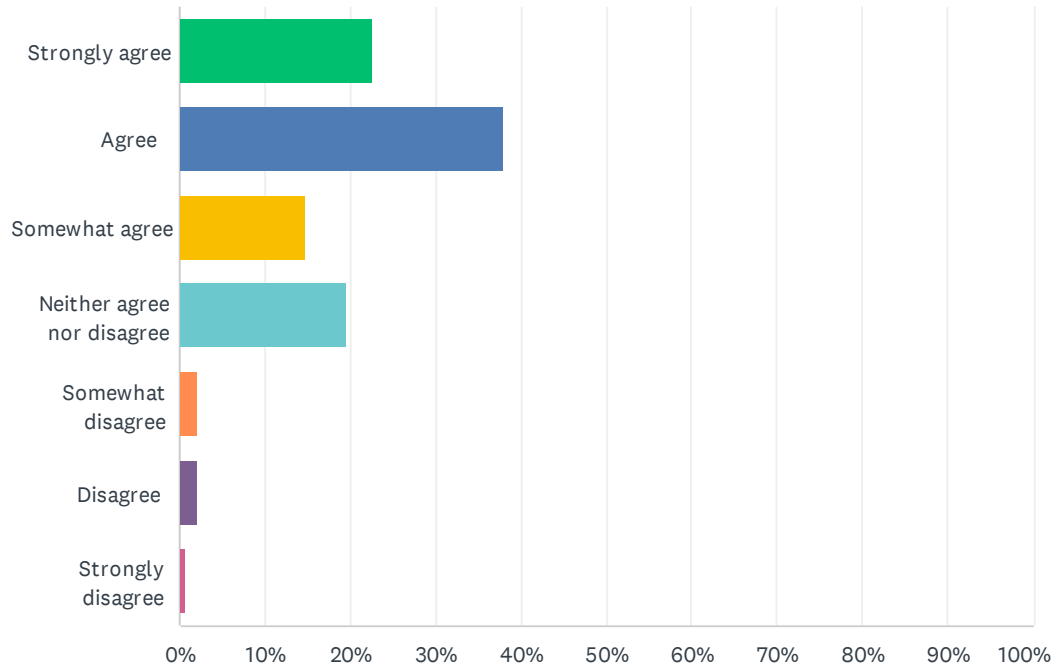

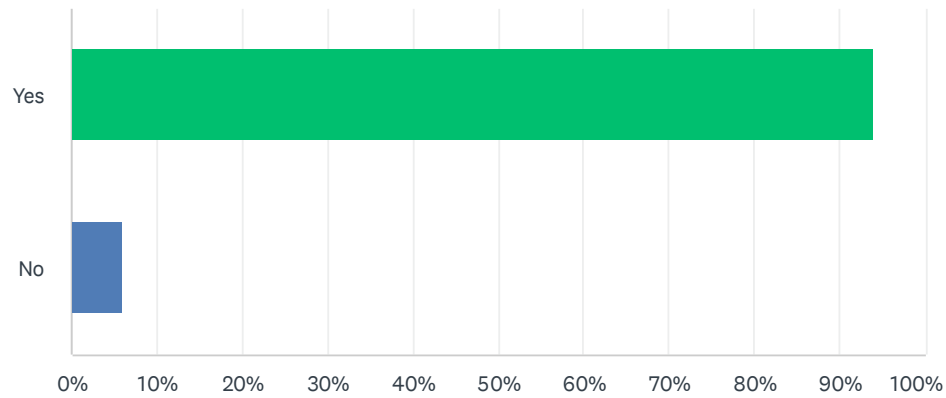

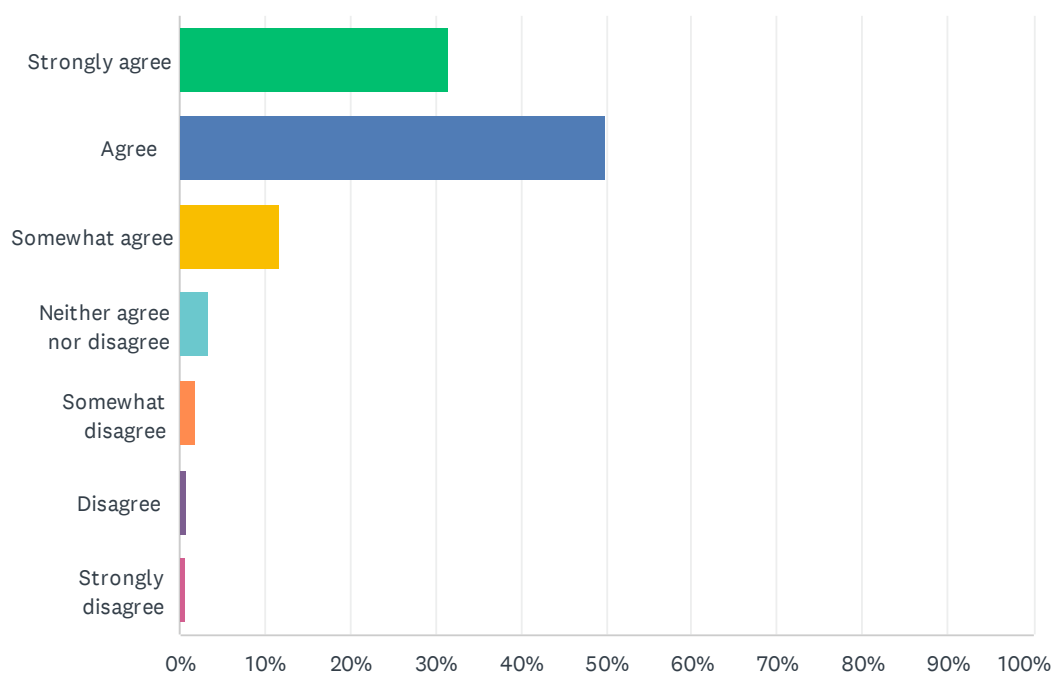

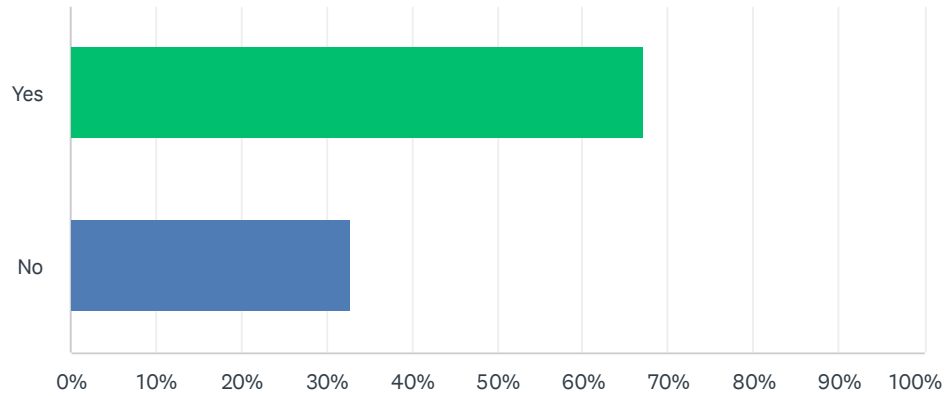

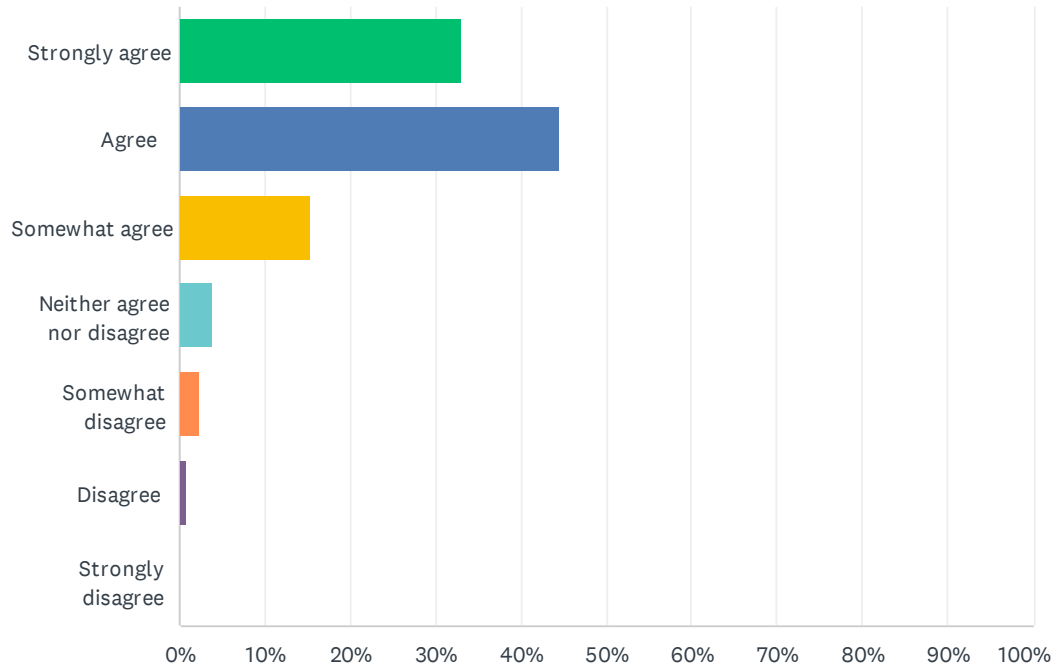

## Q31 I can meaningfully apply my skills and abilities as contribution to our Club

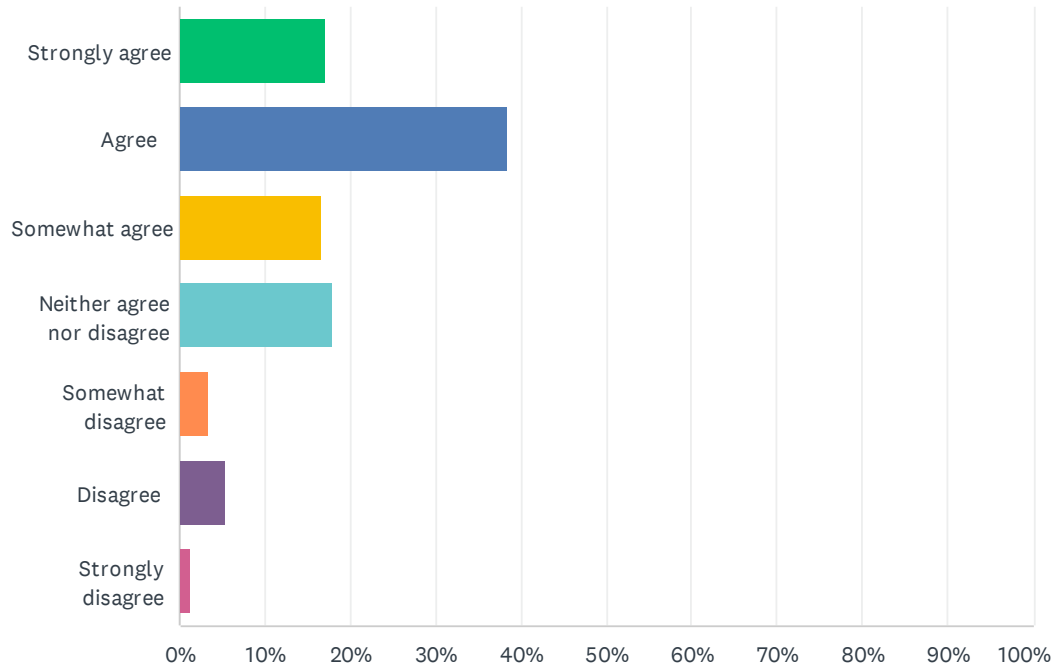

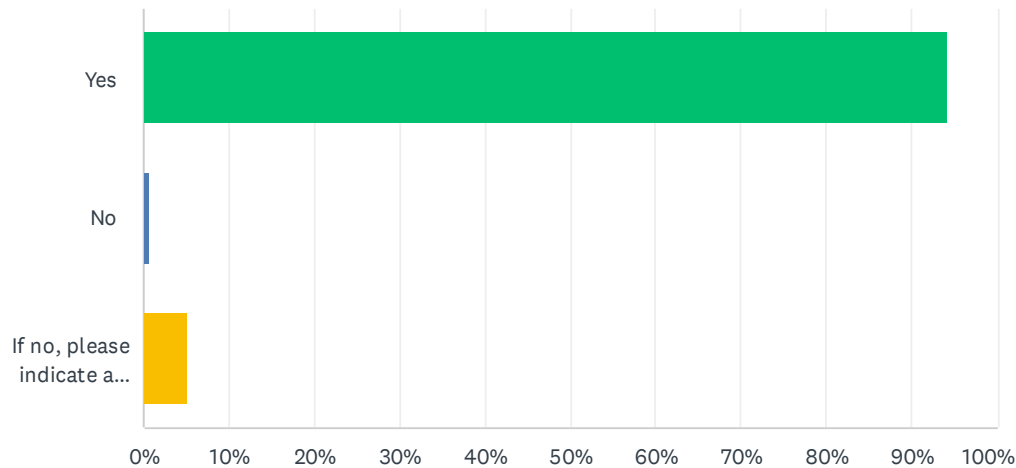

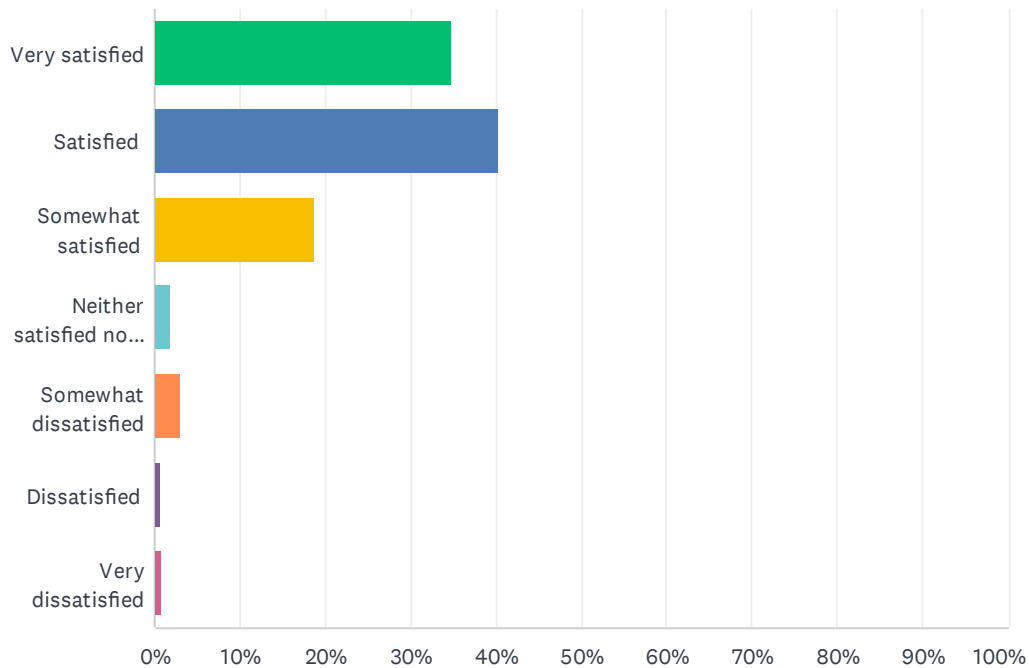

## Q35 Overall, how satisfied are you with your membership in your Rotary Club

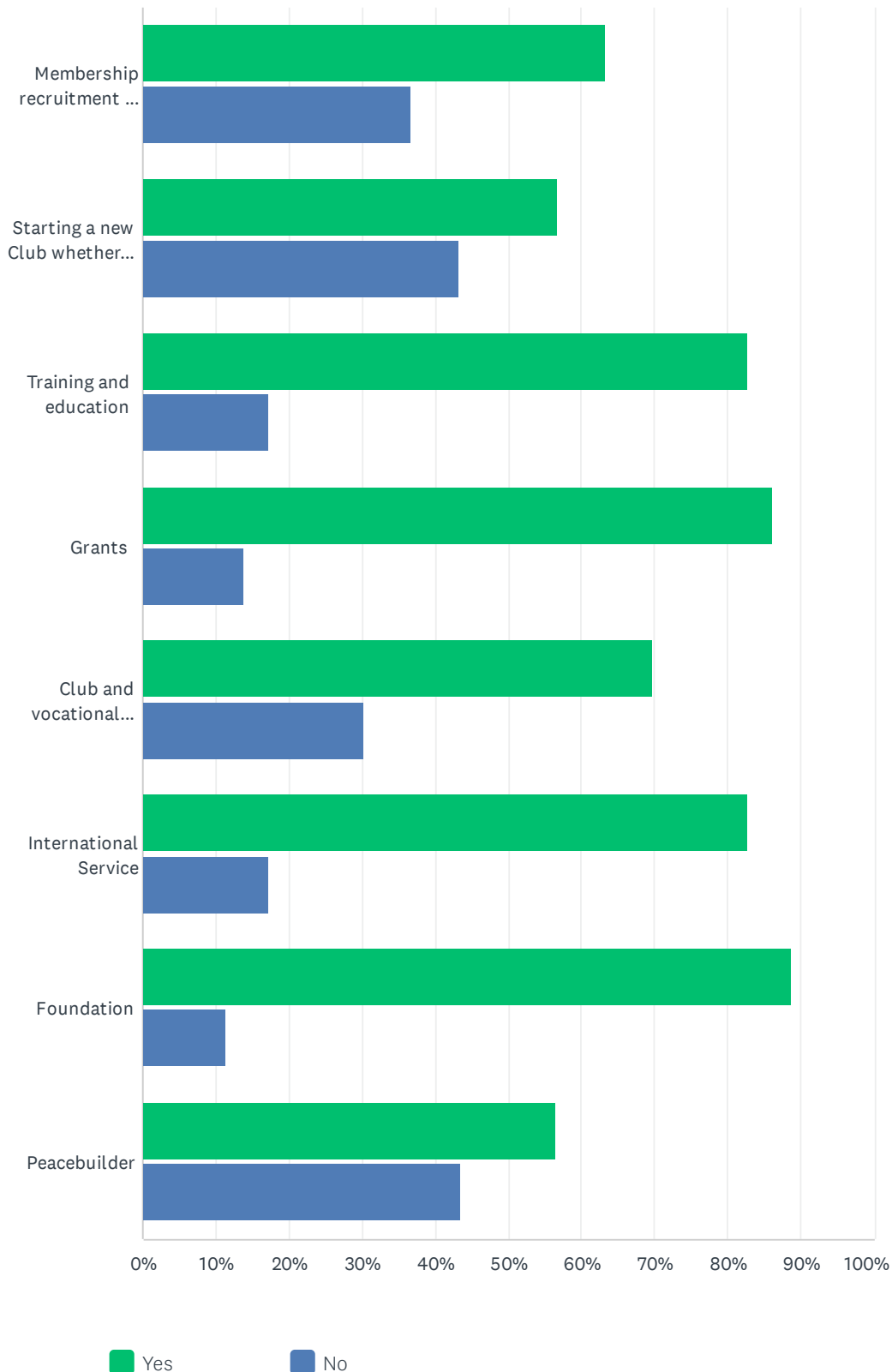

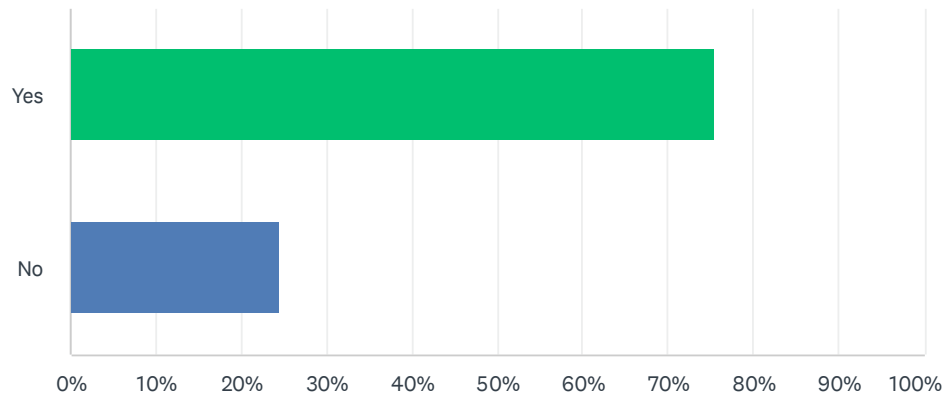

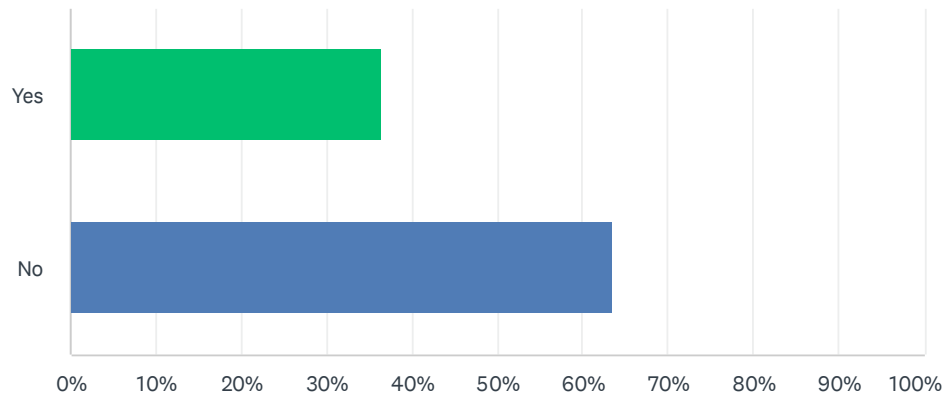

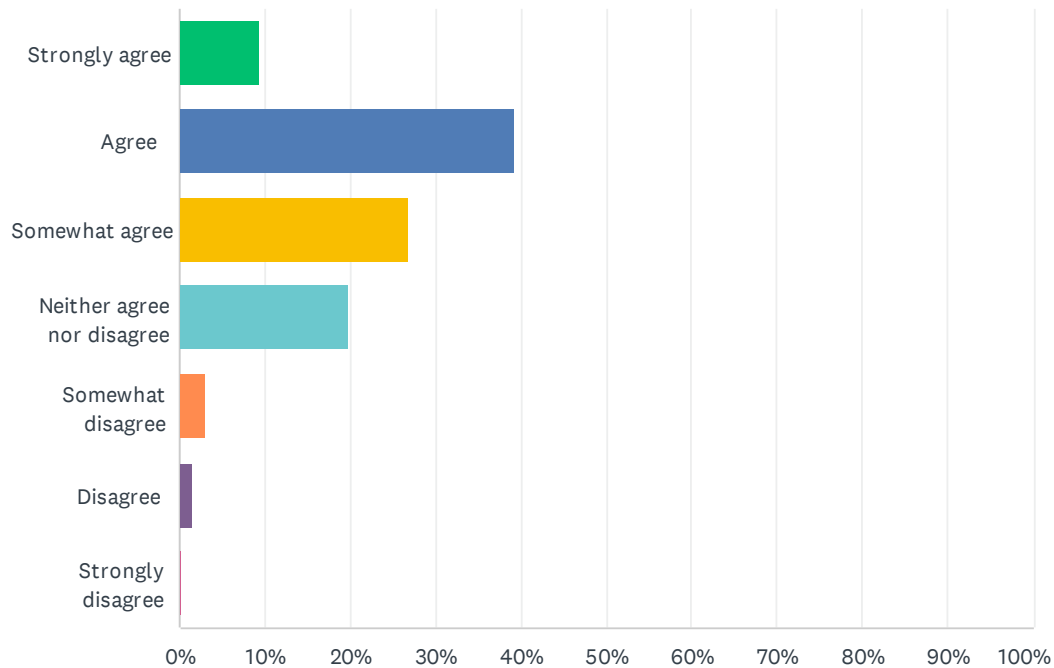

## Q39 Do you feel that you are receiving value from your Rotary District?

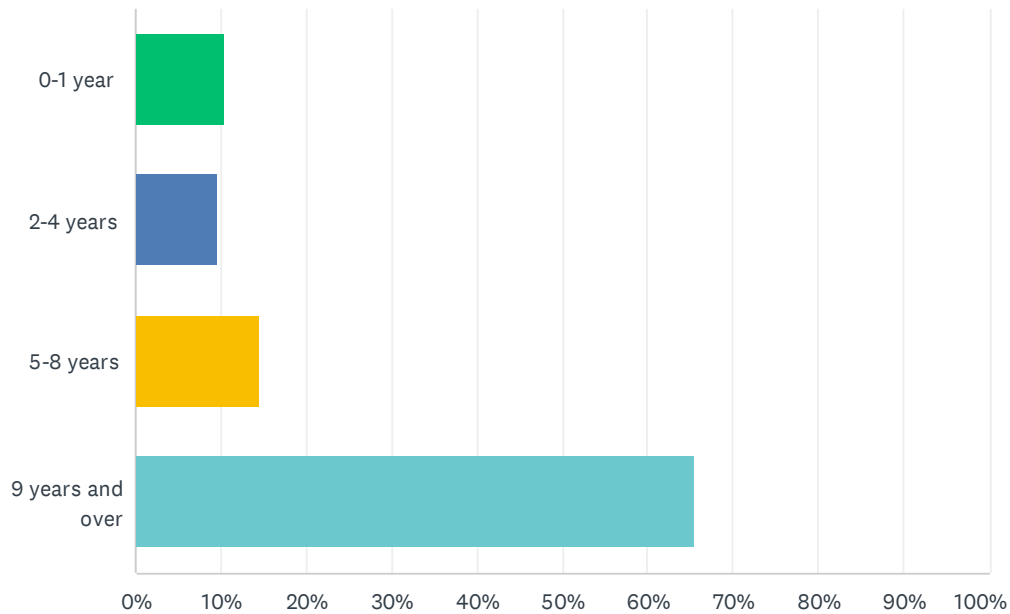
