**APPROXIMATELY 795 MILLION PEOPLE IN THE WORLD ARE CHRONICALLY MALNOURISHED.**

That number is down 167 million over the past decade and 216 million less than in 1990-1992.

**ONE IN EVERY NINE PEOPLE ON OUR PLANET GO TO BED HUNGRY EACH NIGHT.**

The latest estimates show that the proportion of **PEOPLE LIVING ON LESS THAN \$1.25 A DAY FELL** from 43.6 percent in 1990 to 17.0 percent in 2011. Forecasts based on country-specific growth rates in the past 10 years indicate that the extreme poverty rate will fall to 13.4 percent by 2015, a drop of more than two-thirds from the baseline.
