Overview:

Each club may apply for up to \$1500

Rotarian involvement is required; for clubs with up to 35 members, 3 or more members must be involved with planning and implementing the grant project. For clubs with more than 35 members, 5 or more club members must be involved with planning and implementing the project. Collaboration is encouraged within multiple clubs in one area.

Completed, signed applications (electronic signatures are acceptable) to be emailed to Covid19grant@montanarotary.com.

Applications will be reviewed beginning November 20 and are on a first come, first served basis.

Funds are to be used for the following Disaster Relief Areas of Focus:

1. Food Insecurity
2. Housing/Shelter
3. Economic Development
4. Health, Hygiene, Mental Health and Staying Connected

Applicants will be asked to describe what will be accomplished; who the recipients are and how many people will benefit; name any community partners in the project; state how will Rotary be promoted/identified as carrying out the project and to provide a budget with itemized expenses.

Expenses that are part of a Club COVID-19 response project, to be incurred in the future, or incurred after September 1, 2020, may be included.
