PolioPlus Weekly Update



24 May, 2023

Greetings Polio Warriors:

- WILD POLIO VIRUS, TYPE 1 (WPV1) No new cases of WPV1 were reported this week ...
 - **SEVENTY** The number of days since the last case of WPV1 occurred in Afghanistan (April 14, 2023).
 - **NINETY-THREE** The number of days since the last case of WPV1 occurred in Pakistan (February 20th, 2023).
- **TWO HUNDRED & EIGHTY-SEVEN (9 MONTHS +)** The number of days since the last case of WPV1 occurred in Mozambique (August 10th, 2022).
- **THREE** The number of WPV1 cases reported for the year **2023** (1 in Pakistan and 2 in Afghanistan).
- **THIRTY -** The total number of WPV1 cases that occurred in **2022** (2 in Afghanistan, 8 in Mozambique and 20 in Pakistan).
- SIX The total number of WPV1 cases that occurred in **2021** (1 in Pakistan, 1 in Malawi and 4 in Afghanistan).
- ONE HUNDRED & FORTY Total number of WPV1 cases that occurred in 2020.

There was onePositive Environmental Sample reported last week as having been collected on April 23 in the Nangarhar Province of Afghanistan. So the 2023 count increases to 29 Positive Wild Samples (23 in Afghanistan and 6 in Pakistan). The total count of Positive Wild Samples for 2022 remains at 63 (41 in Pakistan and 22 in Afghanistan).

• CIRCULATING VACCINE-DERIVED POLIO - On our other battlefront in the war on polio, the circulating Vaccine-Derived Polio, there were 12 cases of cVDP reported this last week compared to 5 cases the week before. All were from DR Congo with 9 type 2 cases and 3 type 1 cases. However, 1 of each type actually occurred in 2022, but is only now being reported. So this brings the 2023 year's total to 87. The 2022 case total also increases to 860.

There were also 4 Positive Vaccine Derived Environmental Samples (ES) reported this last week, 3 Type 1's from Madagascar and 1 Type 2 from Algeria. However, the 3 from Madagascar were actually collected in 2022. So the total for 2023 increases to 81 and the 2022 count increases to 442.

- PharmaJet's PRECISION DELIVERY SYSTEM (PDS) PharmaJet has donated 5 million Needle-Free PharmaJet Tropis ID syringes for use in WHO's latest polio SIA campaign (supplemental Immunization Activity) that started this month. The inactivated polio vaccine (ID-IPV) campaign will be conducted in two phases in the Southern Districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, near the Pakistan/Afghanistan border where prior cases have originated from. The PharmaJet PDS system was selected based on its proven cost savings, ease of training and improved immunization coverage benefits up to 18%, based on prior usage in a campaign in Somalia and Pakistan in February, 2019. - UPDATE ON THE FLIGHT TO END POLIO Three weeks ago we Introduced Flying Rotarians John Ockenfels and Peter Teahen, who are to circumnavigating the earth in a light airplane to raise awareness and funds for our fight against polio. Last week found our intrepid aviators in Reykjavik, Iceland, after having flown 7 hours and 8 minutes from Goose Bay, Labrador. Here's a link to a short video showing them just before takeoff in the survival suits they lovingly referred to as their "space suits" (In the Navy we referred to them as "Poopy Suits"...don't ask for an explanation \bigcirc). They've had to alter their flight plan to help make up for maintenance and weather delays, and today (Sunday) found them touching down at Urbe Airport in Rome, Italy, a general aviation airport in the northern end of the city. Enjoy Rome Gentlemen.

Poliovirus Weekly Update 24 May, 2023, World Health Organization

You will see below, that the number of wild polio cases for 2023 as of May 24th is 3 (2 in Afghanistan and 1 in Pakistan).

You will also see that the 2022 count remains at 30 (2 in Afghanistan, 20 in Pakistan and 8 in Mozambique).

The total number of wild polio cases in **2021** were **6** (1 in Pakistan, 1 in Malawi and 4 in Afghanistan).

The total number of wild polio cases in **2020** were **140** (84 in Pakistan and 56 in Afghanistan).

The total number of wild polio cases in **2019** were **176** (147 in Pakistan and 29 in Afghanistan).
