- June
 - DGE, DRFC and DGSC submit approved Grant Applications to TRF
- July
 - TRF Reviews Grant and distributes Funds to District 5390
- Jul I Rotary Year begins!





- Clubs must be Qualified to receive any District Grant Funds both District and Global Grants
- All reporting must be submitted to MatchingGrants.org website
- Jan 31st is FINAL DAY to
- Submit MOU, FMP, and proof of tax filing
- Be current on grant reporting, have completed Grant Training, have dues current, attended PETS, etc.
- Progress Report Suggest making a History Log entry to let Audit Committee know there is a report to review
- Grant Worksheet on District website is for use in gathering project information and should not be uploaded to club project
- Rotary Club must be lead on the project
- Club matching funds must be paid from a Club Financial Account
- Start Early!


DISTRICT GRANT CRITICAL DATES:

Aug 1 - Nov 30 - Have 2 club members attend District Grant Training
 January 31 - Clubs must be Qualified to receive any District or Global grant funds.
 March 31 - District Grant Applications are due and must be in a "Signed" status.
 July 31 - District Grant Award Applicants last day to upload "Proof of Club matching Funds"

December 1 and June 1 - Progress Reports due on those Grant Award Projects not yet completed.

FINAL REPORTS DUE within 30 days of Grant Award Project Completion.




