Definition of Rotary

Rotary is an organization of business and professional leaders united worldwide, who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations, and help build goodwill and peace in the world. There are approximately 1.2 million Rotarians, members of more than 32,000 Rotary clubs in 200 countries and geographical areas.

A Brief History

On February 23, 1905, Paul P. Harris, a Chicago lawyer, called three friends to a meeting. What he had in mind was a club that would kindle fellowship among members of the business community. It was an idea that grew from his desire to find within the large city the kind of friendly spirit that he knew in the villages where he had grown up.

The four businessmen didn't decide then and there to call themselves a Rotary Club, but their get-together, was in fact, the first meeting of the world's first Rotary club. As they continued to meet, adding others to the group, they rotated their meetings among the member's places of business, hence the name. Soon after the club name was agreed upon, one of the new members suggested a wagon wheel design as the club emblem. It was the precursor of the familiar cogwheel emblem now worn by Rotarians around the world. By the end of 1905, the club had 30 members.

The second Rotary club was formed in 1908 half a continent away from Chicago in San Francisco, California. It was a much shorter leap across San Francisco to Oakland, California, where the third club was formed. Others followed in Seattle, Los Angeles and New York City. Rotary became international in 1910 when a club was formed in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada. The first intermountain club was found in Salt Lake City, Utah in 1911. By 1921 the organization was represented on every continent and the name Rotary International was adopted in 1922.

Administration of Rotary International

Rotary is organized at club, district, and international levels to carry out its program of service. Rotarians are members of their clubs, and the clubs are members of the global association known as Rotary International. Each club elects its own officers and enjoys considerable autonomy within the framework of the standard constitution and by laws of Rotary International. Clubs are grouped into 530 Rotary districts, each led by a district governor who is an officer of Rotary International and represents the RI board of directors in the field. Though selected by the clubs of the district, a governor is elected by all of the clubs worldwide meeting in the RI Convention. A 19-member board of directors, which includes the International president and president-elect, administers Rotary International. These officers are also elected at the convention; the selection process for choosing directors and the nominating committee for president are based on zones, each of which comprises approximately 15 districts.

Rotary International Mission Statement

The mission of Rotary International is to provide service to others, promote integrity and advance world understanding, goodwill and peace through its fellowship of business, professional, and community leaders.

The Object of Rotary

The object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and in particular, to encourage and foster:

- **FIRST.** The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
- **SECOND** High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society.
- **THIRD..** The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business and community life;
- **FOURTH.** The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

Avenues of Service

Based on the Object of Rotary, the Avenues of Service are Rotary's philosophical cornerstone and the foundation on which club activity is based.

Club Service focuses on strengthening fellowship and ensuring the effective functioning of the club

Vocational Service encourages Rotarians to serve others through their vocations and to practice high ethical standards.

Community Service covers the projects and activities the club undertakes to improve life in its community.

International Service encompasses actions taken to expand Rotary's humanitarian reach around the globe and to promote world understanding and peace.

New Generations Service recognizes the positive change implemented by youth and young adults through leadership development activities, service projects, and exchange programs.

Rotary's Principal Motto:

“Service Above Self”

The Four-Way Test

The test, which has been translated into more than 100 languages, asks the following questions:

Of the things we think, say, or do:

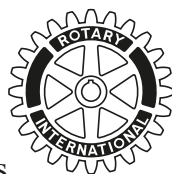
- 1. Is it the **TRUTH**?
- 2. Is it **FAIR** to all concerned?
- 3. Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**?
- 4. Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned?

Diversity and Rotary

Rotary International recognizes the value of diversity within individual clubs. Rotary encourages clubs to assess those in their communities who are eligible for membership, under existing membership guidelines, and to endeavor to include the appropriate range of individuals in their clubs. A club that reflects its community with regard to professional and business classification, gender, age religion, and ethnicity is a club with the key to its future.

The Rotary Emblem

Rotary's first emblem was a simple wagon wheel (in motion with representing civilization in movement.



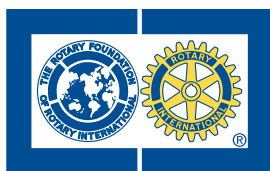
Designer Montague Bear designed this emblem in 1905. As a result, many Rotary clubs of the time adopted the wheel in one form or another. In 1922, authorization was given to create and preserve an official emblem, and the following year the present gear wheel with 24 cogs and six spokes was adopted. A keyway was added to signify that the wheel was a “worker and not an idler.” At the Rotary International Convention in 1929, royal blue and gold were chosen as the official colors.

The Rotary Foundation Mission Statement

The Mission of The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International is to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education and alleviation of poverty.

The Rotary Foundation

In 1917, Arch Klumph, Rotary's sixth president, proposed to the Rotary International Convention in Atlanta, Georgia, USA,



the creation of an “endowment fund for Rotary...for the purpose of doing good in the world in charitable, educational, and other avenues of community service.” A few months later, the endowment received its first contribution of \$26.50 from the Rotary Club of Kansas City, Missouri, USA.

In 1928, when the endowment fund had grown to more than US \$5,000, the fund was renamed The Rotary Foundation, and it became a distinct entity within Rotary International. After Rotary founder Paul P. Harris died in 1947, contributions began pouring in to Rotary International, and the Paul Harris Memorial Fund was created for the purpose of building the Foundation.

The Rotary Foundation Motto:

“Doing Good In The World”

The Declaration of Rotarians in Businesses and Professions was adopted by the Rotary International Council on Legislation in 1989 to provide more specific guidelines for high ethical standards called for in the Object of Rotary:

- Consider my vocation to be another opportunity to serve; Be faithful to the letter and to the spirit of the ethical codes of my vocation, to the laws of my country, and to the moral standards of my community;
 - Do all in my power to dignify my vocation and to promote the highest ethical standards in my chosen vocation;
 - Be fair to my employer, employees, associates, competitors, customers, the public, and all those with whom I have a business or professional relationship;
 - Recognize the honor and respect due to all occupations which are useful to society;
 - Offer my vocational talents to provide opportunities for young people, to work for the relief of the special needs of others, and to improve the quality of life in my community;
 - Adhere to honesty in my advertising and in all representations to the public concerning my business or profession;
 - Neither seek from nor grant to a fellow Rotarian a privilege or advantage not normally accorded others in a business or professional relationship.

District Information

Origin and History of District

Rotary came to the intermountain area only six years after Paul Harris organized Club number 1 in Chicago. In 1911, Salt Lake City had the distinction of receiving Charter No. 24. The first club in Idaho was Boise, chartered June 17, 1917 quickly followed by Idaho Falls in February 1918 and both Twin Falls and Pocatello in April 1918. There were no Rotary "Districts" until 1915 – in that year District 14 was established comprising Idaho, Utah, Colorado, Montana and Wyoming. In 1918 redistricting became necessary and Idaho, Montana, Utah and Western Wyoming were grouped together as District 20. Four years later Utah and Idaho became District 5. Our present area, along with Utah, was District 110 from 1937 until 1949 when the designation was changed to District 165 and then in 1957 to District 542. Utah and Idaho were separated on July 1, 1980 when the present District 540 was established covering Malheur County in Oregon; Idaho, south of the Salmon River; and the Northeast corner of Elko County, Nevada. Due to computerization within Rotary International, the District number was changed in 1990 to District 5400. District 5400 has had one Rotary International President, Richard Wells, a member of the Pocatello Club, in 1944-1945. In 2002, the Ontario Rotary Club changed its name to the Western Treasure Valley Rotary Club. The Boise East Rotary Club and the Twin Falls After Hours Club were chartered in 2010.

Kalyan Banerjee

Kalyan Banerjee is chair of United Phosphorus, Bangladesh, and a director of United Phosphorus Ltd., one of the largest manufacturers of agrochemicals in India, and Uniphos Agro Industries Ltd. Born in Kolkata in 1942, he earned a degree in chemical engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, in 1964. He is a resident of Vapi, Gujarat, where he has contributed significantly to its development as one of the largest industrial estates in India, helping to provide infrastructure for health care and education.

Banerjee has been a member of the Rotary Club of Vapi since 1972. He served as club president in 1975-76 and district governor in 1980-81. He began his international service to Rotary in 1995, with his appointment to the RI Board of Directors. He has gone on to serve as general coordinator of the Poverty and Hunger Alleviation Task Force (1997-98), trustee of The Rotary Foundation (2001-05), and chair of the Southeast Asia PolioPlus Committee (2009-10). He has served on numerous other committees, including the International PolioPlus Committee (2008-09), Reach Out to Africa Ad-Hoc Executive Committee (2009-10), Leadership Development and Training Committee (2009-10), Permanent Fund Committee for India (2008-09), and the Child Mortality Emphasis Coordinating Team (2008-09).

Banerjee is also active in many other organizations, including the American Chemical Society, Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers, and the Senate of the Vishva-Bharati University. He has served twice as president of Vapi Industries Association and is a past chair of the Gujarat Council of the Confederation of Indian Industry. In addition, he is a trustee for the Jai Research Foundation.

Kalyan Banerjee is married to Binota, a social worker, and they have two children and four grandchildren.

Darl Bennett



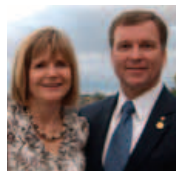

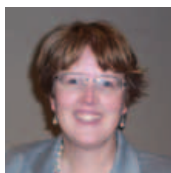

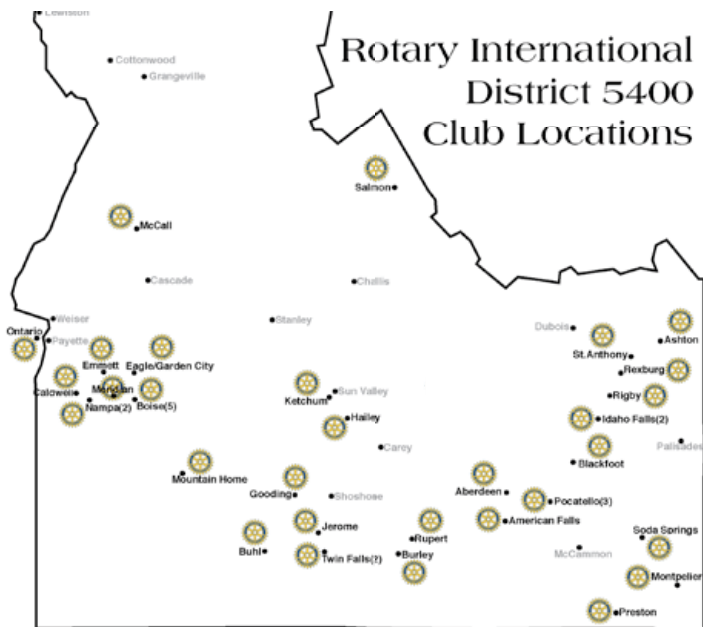
