Canton Panabaj School is located in the community of Canton Panabaj, Municipality of SANTIAGO ATITLÁN in the Department of SOLOLÁ

Description of Project: The project is the construction of four accessible new classrooms and new washrooms with one fully accessible toilet and wash stations and health and hygiene training.

Status: two of the four classrooms are 100% complete and fully furnished with white boards and desks. The construction of the other two classrooms and washrooms are progressing well. It is estimated the project will be complete in two months.

Host Club: Rotary Club of Vista Hermosa.

International Club: Rotary Club of St. Boniface/St. Vital

Cost estimate is \$98,000 US. The municipality and community have committed to provide the skilled and unskilled labour and some materials for an approximate value of \$27,000 US.

Status: The 2025 school year started in mid-February. The RC of Vista Hermosa will provide a list of names and photos of the scholarship recipients for the 2025 school year soon.

The cost for a middle school scholarship is \$160 Canadian and the high school cost is \$650 Canadian at current exchange rates. The total cost for 28 Middle School and 15 High School scholarships is \$16,000 Canadian.

Teacher's Scholarship Program
