Dear Keith,

Thank you for your mail. I was about to send the completed application to you to day. I was just waiting for the Quotation for the benches from Santhosh. I remember your last mail that the application has to be submitted to DGSC not later than October 31st. We were working for the last few weeks for the identification of deserving schools in our area for the Matching Grant. We had a list of around 200 schools in and around Rajapalayam and we have selected 56 schools for the project. The total budget amounts to US\$41,500.00 (764 Desks at a cost of INR 2550.00 or US\$54.25) as you can see in the application. The members of our Rotary Club were of the opinion that a part of the Matching Grants should go to our Rotary School. Accordingly we have prepared the Project Budget and it works out to 663 pairs of Steel Desks and Benches. We hope you will agree with this proposal. We have allotted the benches to deserving schools and the number of Desks to each school ranges from 2 to 30. We were surprised to see Junior schools (up to 5th level) in remote areas where there are only 10 or 12 students. One school has asked for only one set of Desk and we have allotted two sets. If we calculate the total requirement of the Desks for all the schools it may go up to 5000 sets. 663 desks is a good number and it is going to give a good impact in the society here once the project is over. I am attaching the signed application form and quotation obtained from the Rotary school. I will send the quotation for the benches tomorrow. On November we have a Polio Plus Workshop at Rajapalayam since District Polio Chairman Dr. Gothandaraman is from our club. We hope to get the signature from our DG and DRFC on that day in the application form. Thank you Keith. If anything else is missing for the grant application please mail me.


