ACTIVITIES

The library books for El Dormido and Taxisco/San Antonio were donated and transported to Guatemala by Diane and Royce Smith.

The library books and storage cabinets were given to El Dormido in 2011 when the school was finished.

The library books, text books, and storage cabinets will be given to Taxisco/San Antonio when that school is finished.

The Smith's gave the DVDs to the schools in La Montanita and Poza Verde and the scholarships to students at schools in El Jute and Santa Inez.

NOTE: the new President of Guatemala has stated that his administration will provide some quantity of text books for the country's school system. We are waiting to see if that is true, or just a campaign promise, so we are holding some funds because we do not want to have WCS pay for something the government may pay for. If the President steps up, we will use WCS funds to supplement/complement what the government provided, probably in the area of school supplies/materials/equipment.
