Located in downtown Duluth, Life House is northeastern Minnesota's largest provider of comprehensive services to homeless and street youth. Life House serves approximately 700 teens and young adults ages 14-24 annually through its four core programs: the drop-in Youth Center, Housing Program, Mental Health & Wellness Program, and the Futures Program. Life House's clients are disproportionately living in poverty (95%) and over half are youth of color

(20% African American, 15% Native American, and 22% multiple races). Two-thirds have been homeless at least once, and one in three is homeless when they first arrive at the drop-in center.

Life House recently received major grant funding to expand its Futures Program, offering a new paid job training program geared specifically toward homeless youth who lack the stability needed to maintain employment in the community. The year-long program teaches participants entrepreneurship and computer skills through the hands-on process of creating a small business

The proposed project will assist Life House in renovating a classroom and workshop space for the jobs training program in the building directly next door to Life House's current headquarters, along with purchasing equipment necessary to advance the training opportunities for area youth. The current building owner has agreed to sell Life House this two-story, 1,700 square foot building, with an anticipated closing date of June 1, 2017. The projected start date is August 1, 2017, with estimated completion by October 15, 2017.

The mission of The Rotary Foundation is to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty. How will this project meet the mission of Rotary Foundation?

The Futures Program helps youth with limited education and job skills to become self-sufficient by providing high school credit recovery, GED tutoring, independent living skills classes, and job placement services.

Life House will own and maintain the building and all equipment. The paid staff will not only operate but train students in the Futures Program on operation of the laptop designated for this program. The items are stored in a secured space, and entry to the building is locked and entrance to the building is screened by the front desk personnel. There is also a security system (including camera) at the building's entrance.

Will training in use and maintenance of technical equipment (including software) be provided? If so, who will provide training?

See answer above; paid and trained staff in turn will train students on use of computer.

Describe how the benefiting community will maintain this project after grant funding has been fully expended.

At the conclusion of the renovation project, Life House anticipates that youth product sales will reach a profit level sufficient to contribute to the program costs. The Futures Program is one of their core programs, and Life House's professional development team is committed to sustaining it by expanding funding sources to include individual donors, government and foundation grants, corporate sponsorships, and fundraising special events.

Describe specific activities of the benefiting community partners in implementing the project.

Life House has an experienced and tenured Operations Director on staff who is coordinating the purchase of all of the supplies and equipment, as well as contracting and overseeing the paid labor provided by a local construction firm. Finally, she will also schedule and oversee the volunteer labor hours supplied by Harbortown Rotarians and other community partners.

Harbortown Rotary Club has already established a Community Service Sub-Committee who

works with Life House and their Operations Director on an on-going basis to plan and execute projects at their facilities. (Life House was designated as our Club's long-term community partner resulting from our '15-'16 visioning and planning session.) This particular project will be completed with this same Rotarian oversight responsibilities assigned to that sub-Committee.

How will Rotarians be involved the project? Please note that financial support is not considered active involvement. (See the District Grant application instructions for suggestions.)

Members of Duluth Harbortown will be instrumental in cleaning and assisting with painting the renovated space. While there may be other community partners that will also volunteer labor hours for these activities, Life House will be primarily dependent on Harbortown to provide.

The Club's portion of the funding has been secured through prior community fundraising events (i.e Lake Superior Dragon Boat Festival, Coffee Sales and Trip Raffle).
