HOTEL INFORMATION

There are now almost **30,000** Rotarians and guests registered for the Atlanta Convention! Therefore, most of the hotel rooms within walking distance of the Georgia World Congress Center where the Convention activities will take place have already been reserved.

No problem! <u>Rotary has recently secured more rooms that are within 20 minutes of the Convention site</u>. Many are in Buckhead, an area with many newer hotels and restaurants. It is on the MARTA train system—an inexpensive and easy way to get to the Convention Center. In addition, Rotary will be providing buses to take you to the Convention.

More rooms should come available after December 5th, when deposits for all Group Reservations are due. However, as of November 26th, the following list are some of the hotels that have rooms available:
