Process steps

1. Fill out the Rotary International District 5580 Youth Volunteer Application and Background Check Form found on the District 5580 website on the Youth Protection Page, or found as Appendix C in the District 5580 Youth Protection Policy (IF you are certified through RYLA or The Central States Youth Exchange program please provide a copy of your certification..)

2. The Youth Volunteer application allows the District to do a background check, You will receive an email with easy instructions to follow from InCheck.. None of your information is shared with anyone except InCheck.. The results are seen only by the Youth Protection Officer, the Youth Exchange Chair, the District Governor, You will be notified when it is complete. IF any questions come up the Youth Protection Officer will contact you..
3. Next you need to complete the Boy Scouts of America online Youth Protection Training.. The Boy Scout training is very informative.. It costs nothing but time.. And may take several visits to complete all the modules that you need and wish to complete.. But it is worth it.

Go to - <https://my.scouting.org> - sign in and create your user ID / password etc
Next go to the Youth Protection Training by clicking on the English version of the medallion.. Complete the necessary and extra modules as you choose.. When complete print out your certificate of completion..
