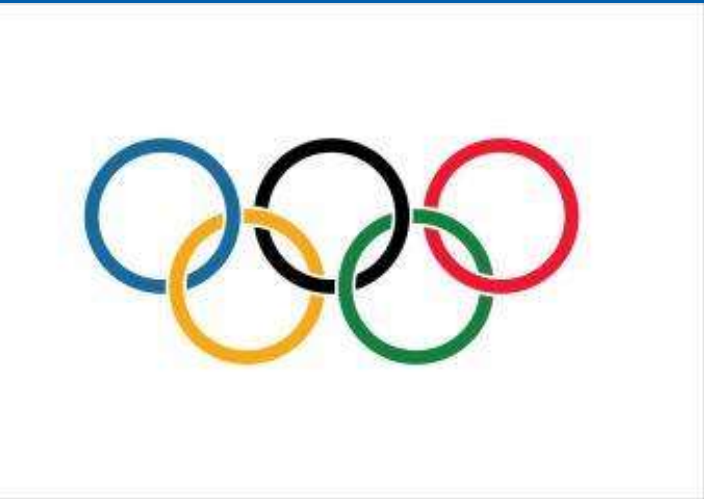

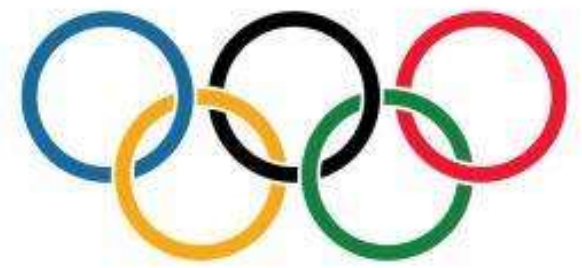

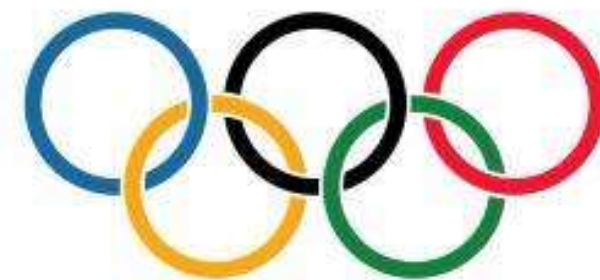

Listen and we will tell you – but first some background -



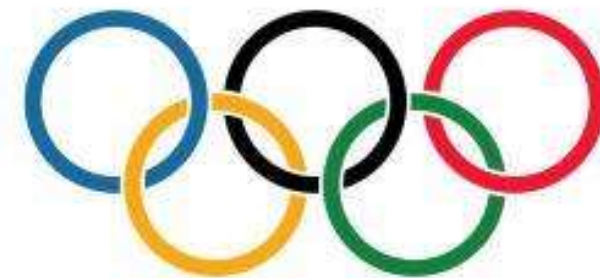
Membership *Background Information*

- *Of the 328 we lost, 109 or 33% were members for less than three years.*

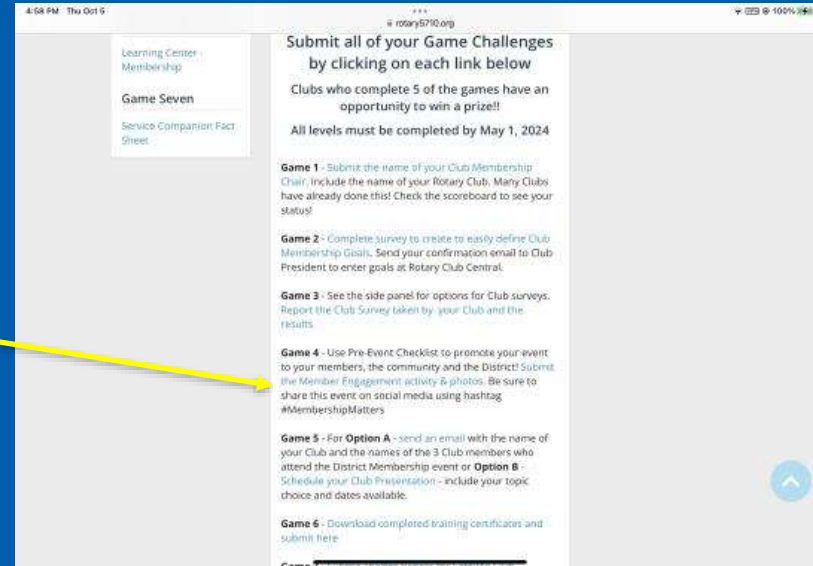

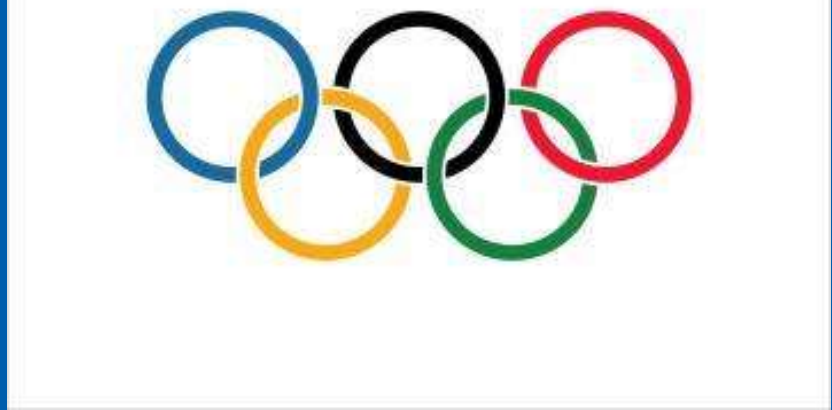
