\$200,000,000 Two Hundred Million Dollars. That's a lot of zero's, but nothing compared to the thought of ending the threat of Polio in our world. We have a challenge, and that challenge is to raise the match of \$200m. By now we have all heard that if every Rotary Club raised \$6,000 that would do it. If every 1.2 million of us Rotarians would give \$167 that would also do it. I know we will raise the funds and that we will beat Polio. Alumni have already contributed \$345,000 to Polio and Alumni Ray Klingensmith has challenged all Alumni to contribute 1 million by the time of our International Convention in New Orleans. As

of 31 December 2010, we have raised \$160 million dollars. We are almost there.

Since our start in 1985, the advances made toward the elimination of Polio have been outstanding. The development of new vaccines has made the job of immunizing children easier and more effective. Rotary plays an important part in the eradication effort with our non-political stance, we can get to places where others cannot.

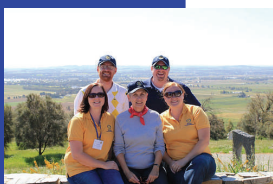
