Leavenworth	Provide 3 academic (\$2000) and 2 vocational/technical (\$1000) scholarships to area high school students. Rotarians select the winners, and present awards at a weekly luncheon.	3,396
Leawood	A mentoring and scholarship program for underprivileged juniors and seniors at a local high school. Funds are used for educational materials and scholarships through 4 years of college. Rotarians provide over 500 hours of service a year.	4,017

Manhattan	The club honors one high school senior a month, inviting them to a club meeting. These students then compete for two \$1000 college scholarships.	1,333
