Carol Pandak is the Director of the PolioPlus program at Rotary International. Throughout her career she has worked for national and international nonprofit organizations including Rotary International, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the Society of Actuaries.

Carol directs all aspects of Rotary's polio eradication activities. This includes: serving as the focal point for the core partners in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative WHO, UNICEF and the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation; supporting and guiding Rotary's International PolioPlus Committee; overseeing a large network of global volunteers and committees; grantmaking; and advocacy activities.

Carol also serves on multiple cross agency committees and management groups of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) and is Rotary's representative to the GPEI's Strategy Committee.

Carol has a doctorate degree in Adult Education and is a published author. She has been a lecturer for the International Studies Program in the College of Arts and Sciences at Northwestern University located in Evanston, Illinois where for 10 years she taught a course on nongovernmental organizations from an international perspective.
