*Fund Raising Ideas*

1	Newspaper public announcement requesting \$1 sent in to Rotary Foundation	Checks must be made out to "The Rotary Foundation" and note "Polio Plus"
2	Football Pot	Concept of guessing game/team scores applies to any sport
3	Polio Pig	Like a Piggy Bank – pass the pig for donations at your club, Chamber or other venue meeting
4	Chambers for Polio Eradication	Involve your Chamber of Commerce
5	Immunization Awareness Days	Work with local medical community to raise immunization awareness in general
6	Mock NID	Simulate the 3-day event with getting out flyers, dispensing a mock vaccine to kids for a \$2 donate to represent the two drops of polio vaccine and then a mop-up event
7	\$2 Change donations	Ask local doctors, clinics and Health Department to make polio pamphlets available to families that bring their children in for routine shots. The \$2 donation can simulate the 2 drops of the polio oral vaccine
8	Corporate Donations	Request local corporations to make a donation
9	High School Fund Raising Involvement	Involve local school and/or Interact groups in fund raising. They often have outstanding ideas and energy.
10	Rotary Club Donation Centers	Ask your Rotary meeting location owner to have a donation collection box. Be sure to gather the donations each time your club meets and refresh with polio awareness flyers.
11	Blue Jean Day at Work	Ask your employer if you can charge employees \$5 for wearing blue jeans to work one day a month
12	SWAT Team	Cluster Coordinators are available to come to your Club to discuss polio fund raising, the 4/18 District-wide fund raising event and/or NID information. Contact Robert Thompson at <a href="mailto:ratratrat@yahoo.com">ratratrat@yahoo.com</a> for more SWAT team information.
13	Wine Tasting Party	Sell tickets to your friends and the community to a wine and cheese tasting event. You may want to have a local artist selling their work or musicians involved to raise interest for the event.
14	Happy Bucks	Pass around a collection plate for people to make donations to Polio for things they are happy about
15	Cup Days	Put cups out on the table at your Rotary meetings for people to put in their Polio donations
