Frequently Asked Questions

Q. I have completed the form and have attached it – will you be billing me?

A. No. The actual donation is up to you. The easiest way to make your tax deductible donation is to go to myrotary.org/donate and click on “polio fund”. You and your club will be credited with the donation and will also count towards your Paul Harris.

Q. Why are you asking for this commitment form? What do you do with it?

A. We ask for the commitment form as a personal way for you to show your support for the eradication of polio by pledging an annual minimum donation of \$100 until polio is eradicated. We retain the form and don't send it or share it. The completed form is the only way we know that you are joining the Society. You will be entered into the PolioPlus Society – and soon receive a certificate and if requested, a pin.

Q. Do I have to be a Rotarian to become a member of the PolioPlus Society?

A. No. Anyone who wants to donate at least \$100 annually can become a member of the Society. Yes, even those who are not (yet!) Rotarians will receive a pin and a certificate. We will ask the Assistant Governor to help us with the delivery.

Q. I am already donating to PolioPlus (at least \$10 a month). Am I able to join the Society?

A. Yes. By completing the form pledging your annual donation of \$100 or more until polio is eradicated. Please send the form to D5710 PolioPlus Chair maria Wilson at Maria4PolioPlus@gmail.com.

Q. Does my donation count toward my Paul Harris?

A. Yes. The money you donate for PolioPlus counts toward your Foundation giving and thus, your Paul Harris points.

Q. Does the money I donate to PolioPlus contribute to the overall Foundation giving?

A. No. 100% of the actual donation goes directly to eradicate polio. These funds are then matched 2 for 1 by the Gates Foundation.
